First, drag a selection line between the arc and the copied line, to identify the elements to extend which in this case are the upper green lines. Then drag a selection line at the right of the copied line to identify the elements to trim. If needed, select the smallest parts to trim individually. Reset to complete.

Place SmartLine is a tool that produces different type of elements depending on used setting. As Daniel Clark wrote, using Join elements checkbox you can define whether a line will be placed as one line string or as a series of independent lines.

How do I see attributes in MicroStation?

- 1. From the References dialog box select the Reference File in the dialog you want to work with.
- 2. From the Reference dialog box pull down menu Settings > Presentation.
- 3. Check ON Use View Flags.
- 4. Toggle ON or OFF the View Attributes you want for the reference file.

How do you curve data in MicroStation?

How do I get northing and easting in MicroStation?

- 1. Answer: Go to Settings > Design File.
- 2. Civil Formatting > Coordinate Settings and change Format to Northing, Easting. Click OK.
- 3. Go to Tools > Civil AccuDraw > Civil AccuDraw Settings.
- 4. Under the Favorites tab click Add and enter a name such as "NEâ€.
- 5. Select the newly customized Civil AccuDraw command.

How do I create a point in coordinates in MicroStation?

- 1. Select a placement tool.
- In the key-in browser type the coordinates: "XY=1000,1000,0″
- 3. Hit the Enter key on the keyboard or the Run icon from the key-in browser.
- Continue to use the key-in browser and the "XY=†key-in to finish placing elements/vertices/cells…

How do you hide an element in MicroStation?

Simply right click on an element and select Hide in View. That element is then hidden.

How do you unlock raster images in MicroStation?

To release the lock, ensure the image is selected and press CTRL+M or choose Edit > Unlock. 2) Lock the level. Since raster attachments are put on a level, you can also lock the level via the Level Manager.

How do I move a contact in MicroStation?

- 1. Select the Move To Contact tool (Drawing > Home > Manipulate > More split button).
- 2. Select the element to move.
- 3. Enter a data point to accept. Moving an element to contact an existing element.

How do I change colors in MicroStation?

To change the background color go under Settings > Color Table. The Modify Color dialog box will come up. Once this is up select the desired color and then click OK.

How do you change the color of an element in MicroStation?

Hold down the data point on the colored box next to the Color option and select a new color. 6. Click on any element. The element's color changes to match the one you selected in the previous step.

How do I create a macro in MicroStation?

- 1. Open any design file.
- 2. Go to Utilities|Macro|Create BASIC Macroâ€
- From the "Create Macro†dialog box, add a name in the "Name:†field and a description in the "Description:†field.
