Quick Answer, how do you draw different **shapes** in **SketchUp**?

Additionally, how do you make an irregular polygon in SketchUp? Draw a large rectangle. Use that as a basis for your smaller **irregular** polygon's edges. If it's to vary only slightly from a regular polygon you could draw one of those, then select it, right-click > context-menu > Explode, to make the perimeter into separate edges.

Similarly, how do I distort a shape in **SketchUp**?

Best answer for this question, how do you **draw** freehand in SketchUp?

1. Select the Move tool ().
2. Hover the cursor over the curve to locate an end point.
3. Click and drag the end point to adjust the curve and release the mouse when you're done.

Press the Up Arrow or Down Arrow key while creating the rectangle. Change the rounding of rounded rectangles. Immediately after you **draw** a rectangle with the Rounded Rectangle tool, you can specify a radius for the rounded corners by typing a unit of measure and the letter r in the Measurements box.

How do you use a shape bender in SketchUp?

Make sure it's parallel to the red axis. Choose Plugins > Chris Fullmer Tools > Shape Bender to activate the tool. Click once on the straight edge you drew in Step 3 (make sure it's highlighted

before you click on it). Click once on the curve you created in Step 4. Wait for SketchUp to think.

How do you make different polygons?

1. You can draw a regular polygon using a circle.
2. You can draw a square.
3. You can draw a regular pentagon, with five equal sides/angles.
4. You can draw a regular hexagon, with six equal sides/angles.
5. You can draw a regular octagon, with eight equal sides/angles.

How do you curve edges in SketchUp?

Double click on the object you want to round the corners of. Then select the "round corner" button from the FreeD6 plugin. Under the "rounding parameters" options select the "offset" button to set the offset amount. Type the desired amount you want to offset the corners by and hit enter.

How do I orient texture in SketchUp?

1. With the Select tool, click the face with the texture you want to edit.
2. Choose Edit > Face > Texture > Position.
3. Edit your texture.
4. Click anywhere outside your texture in your modeling window to exit Texture Edit mode.

How do I texture in SketchUp?

1. In the Colors panel, click the Textures Palette tab (the one with the brick icon).
2. Select the collection where you want the new material to appear.
3. Select Color > New Texture.
4. In the dialog box that appears, select an image file for your texture.

You can also select the Pan tool () by selecting View > Pan. With the Pan tool active, click and drag the Pan cursor in any direction to pan around the document area.

How can you draw a rounded corner rectangle?

1. Double-click the Rectangle tool in the toolbox.
2. The Rounded Corners dialog box appears.
3. Choose a corner setting from the preset shapes.
4. Click on OK.
5. Click and drag anywhere on the screen.
6. Release the mouse button when the rectangle is the desired size.

What is an irregular polygon shape?

An irregular polygon is a 2D shape that has straight sides that are not equal to each other and angles that are not equal to each other.

What is irregular polygon called?

An irregular polygon does not have all its sides equal and not all the angles are equal in measure. Examples of irregular polygons are scalene triangle, right triangle, isosceles triangle, rectangle, parallelogram, irregular pentagon, irregular hexagon, etc.

With the Line tool (), click and drag to draw the line. As you drag, a curvature control extends from the start point. Release the mouse button, and without clicking, move the cursor to set the curve's direction and size, as shown on the left in the following figure.
