Enter CUI on the command line to open the Customize User Interface dialog box. On the Transfer tab, in the right panel, open the newly created CUI **file**. Select the workspace you want to import and drag the workspace into the Workspaces section of the Main CUI file in the left panel.

Additionally, how do I open a **CUI file** in AutoCAD?

1. Enter CUI at the command line.
2. Under Workspaces, select the current workspace.
3. Under Workspace Contents, click Customize Workspace.
4. Expand menus on the left-hand column and tick the boxes of the ones to be added as needed.
5. Under Workspace Contents, click Done.
6. Click OK.

Quick Answer, how do I **import** a CUIX file?

1. Copy the CUIX file to the default location for the new AutoCAD version.
2. Open the target version of **AutoCAD**.

3. Enter **CUI** at the command line.
4. Go to the Transfer tab.
5. Under the Customizations in New File header, click Open and select the CUIX file in question.

You asked, where is the **CUI file in AutoCAD**? In Windows Explorer or File Explorer, navigate to :Users\AppDataRoaming\Autodesk\support. cuix.

Beside above, how do I **import** a classic workspace in AutoCAD?

1. From the Manage tab in the ribbon, click Import.
2. In the customization editor, click the Transfer tab.
3. In the left pane, load the configuration **file**, acad.
4. From the workspace list in the left pane, drag AutoCAD Classic to the workspace list in the right pane.

In the Customize User Interface (CUI) Editor, Transfer tab, in the left pane, click the Open Customization File button. In the Open dialog box, browse to and select the customization file (MNU, MNS, CUI, or CUIx) from which you want to transfer user interface elements from. Click Open.

What is CUI file in AutoCAD?

The Customize User Interface (CUI) Editor allows you to modify many of the user interface elements that are used to start a command in the program. Customizing the user interface allows you to change the placement of the tools that you commonly use, and to add new tools that can improve your productivity.

How do I import a CUIx file into AutoCAD 2022?

Click the Open customization file button on the right pane (pictured to the right). Select the CUIX file you saved to the external hard drive. 6. Select the workspace you want to transfer, and drag it into the Workspaces section in the left panel.

How do I add a workspace in AutoCAD 2022?

1. In AutoCAD, on the ribbon, click View tab > Palettes panel > Tool Palettes.
2. Reposition the Tool Palettes window on-screen based on your preference of location.
3. In AutoCAD, on the status bar, click Workspace Switching.
4. On the menu, choose Save Current As.

What is CUI file?

Saves workspace settings for AutoCAD architectural drawing and engineering software as well as for 3ds Max 3D modeling software; contains toolbar and menu configuration settings as well as the layout for windows and palettes; used for setting up the workspace for different modeling, rendering, and animation tasks.

How do I open custom user interface in AutoCAD?

1. You can type in "CUI" in the command line.
2. You can also click the dropdown (drop-up??)
3. Each of the three ways will get you to the Customize User Interface window.
4. In the upper LEFT window, Left Click to Select the workspace you want to customize.

How do I restore a CUIx file in AutoCAD?

1. Select "Restore acad. cuix" to restore the CUIx to its last save state.
2. Select "Reset acad. cuix" to reset the CUIx to its original installed state.

How do I create a classic workspace in AutoCAD 2021?

1. Click Tools menu > Workspaces > Save Current As.
2. In the Save Workspace dialog box, in the Name box, type AutoCAD Classic.
3. Click Save.

How do I get the classic toolbar in AutoCAD 2020?

1. Click Tools menu > Toolbars and select the required toolbar.
2. Repeat until all required toolbars are visible.

What are the 3 workspace types in AutoCAD?

1. 2D Drafting ribbon workspace " customized for those who are familiar with the AutoCAD ribbon and work primarily with drawing data.
2. Planning And Analysis ribbon workspace " customized for AutoCAD Map 3D toolset commands.

How do I add a drawing toolbar in AutoCAD?

1. On the command line, enter MENUBAR and set the value to 1.
2. Click the Tools > Toolbars menu and select the desired toolbar(s).

How do I enable command line in AutoCAD?

Use the shortcut CTRL+9 (CMD+3 in AutoCAD for Mac) to toggle on the command line. Type in the COMMANDLINE command. It may be necessary to enable Dynamic Input to do this see How to enable or disable dynamic input in AutoCAD: Right-click on either Dynamic input or Object Snap in the Status Bar and select Settings.

How do I edit a CUIX file?

cui file is an XML file format, which can be edited using any ASCII or Unicode text editor. However, it is best to edit .cui files using an XML editor such as Visual Studio or Notepad++. If you are developing with progeCAD, you already have Visual Studio.

How do I import a custom workspace in AutoCAD?

Enter CUI on the command line to open the Customize User Interface dialog box. On the Transfer tab, in the right panel, open the newly created CUI file. Select the workspace you want to import and drag the workspace into the Workspaces section of the Main CUI file in the left panel.

How do I copy a workspace in AutoCAD?

What is the default design workspace in AutoCAD 2022?

Workspaces. AutoCAD Architecture 2022 toolsets equipped with one single default workspace (Architecture). The menus and commands associated with the previously provided workspaces (Design, Document, Detailing, and Visualization) can be accessed from the tabs of the ribbon.
