## Introduction

To combine two split sketch entities into one: In an open sketch, click the split point and press Delete. Search "Combining Split Entities"™ in the **SOLIDWORKS** Knowledge Base.

Quick Answer, how do you merge overlapping sketches in SolidWorks?

Also the question is, how do I link a sketch from one part to another in SolidWorks?

1. Select the closed sketch in the FeatureManager design tree.
2. Click Edit > Copy or press Ctrl+C.
3. Click in the **sketch** or document where you want to paste the center of the **sketch**.
4. Click Edit > Paste or press Ctrl+V.

Moreover, how do you link lines in **SolidWorks**? You can apply connection lines automatically when you add center marks to a drawing view at the time of creation. In a drawing, click Tools > Options > Document Properties > Detailing , and under Auto insert on view creation, select Connection lines to hole patterns with center marks.

As many you asked, how do you coincide two points in SolidWorks?

1. Select a line, point, center line or temporary axis with the left mouse button.
2. Hold the "Control" key and select the second line, point or temporary axis by left-clicking it.
3. Click the "Coincident" button in the Add Relations section of the properties box.

Then you can use Combine on the multibody part. (Features toolbar) or Insert > Features > Combine. In the PropertyManager, under Operation Type, select Add. For Bodies to Combine, select the bodies to combine.

## **Why can't I combine in Solidworks?**

You can only combine bodies contained within one multibody part file. You cannot combine two separate parts. However, you can create a multibody part by using Insert Part to place one part into the other part file. Then you can use Combine on the multibody part.

## **Can you copy a sketch into another part in SOLIDWORKS?**

Pick the top of a feature tree for a component and select Edit > Copy. Then go to a drawing and select Edit > Paste. SOLIDWORKS has now inserted, or pasted, a copy of that component in a model view in the drawing.

## **How do you copy a sketch from one plane to another?**

You can simply select your sketch in the Feature Manager, invoke the Copy function, select the face or plane on which you want the copy, and then select Paste. Viola!

## **How do you copy and paste something into sketches?**

1. Select the closed sketch in the FeatureManager design tree.
2. Click Edit > Copy or press Ctrl+C.
3. Click in the sketch or document where you want to paste the center of the sketch.
4. Click Edit > Paste or press Ctrl+V.

## **How do I merge shapes in SolidWorks?**

1. Click Combine. (Features toolbar) or Insert > Features > Combine.
2. In the PropertyManager, under Operation Type, select Add.
3. For Bodies to Combine, select the bodies to combine. You can select bodies in the graphics area or the Solid Bodies.
4. Click Show Preview to preview the feature.
5. Click .

## How do I merge splines in SolidWorks?

1. Start SolidWorks in Part Mode.
2. Front Plane>>sketch.
3. Draw another spline tangent to this one.
4. Under sketch tab click the spline tool arrow and select fit spline.
5. Select the spline one by one.
6. Click OK and we can notice that two splines are merged into one.
7. Extrude the surface.

## What does coincident mean in SolidWorks?

Coincident. A point and a line, arc, or ellipse. The point lies on the line, arc, or ellipse. Equal. Two or more lines or two or more arcs.

## How do you do a Pierce relationship in SolidWorks?

To apply a pierce relation a line and a sketch point are required. Either use the "Add Relation" option or use the control key to select and highlight the two entities you are wanting to combine with a pierce relationship.

## How do you constrain a sketch in SolidWorks?

Click Options (Features toolbar) or Insert > FeatureWorks > Options . Click Dimensions/Relations and select Enable Auto Dimensioning of Sketches and Add constraints to sketch. Click OK.

## How do you join faces in Solidworks?

Select faces and surfaces for Surfaces and Faces to Knit . Select Try to form solid to create a solid model from enclosed surfaces. Select Merge entities to merge faces with the same underlying geometry.

## How do you combine two parts of an assembly?

## Where is Combine command in Solidworks?

The Combine feature lives under Insert>Features>Combine. The common function allows you to add two bodies together, and keep the area that is common to them. To use this feature, we will select the common button, and then under Bodies to Combine, select the two bodies.

## What is merge result in Solidworks?

The Merge results option of the Base Flange/Tab command lets you merge bodies with coplanar faces. To merge sheet metal bodies by adding a base flange: in a multibody sheet metal part, move the bodies to be merged to the same plane.

## How do you move a sketch to another plane in SOLIDWORKS?

The first and more straightforward way to move a sketch to a different face is to right-click on the sketch in the feature tree. From there, you can click the button to "Edit sketch plane." This will highlight the existing face, and all you need to do to move it is to select the new face.

## How do you split a sketch into multiple sketches in SOLIDWORKS?

1. In an open sketch, click Split Entities. (Sketch toolbar) or Tools > Sketch Tools > Split Entities .
2. Click the sketch entity at the location where you want the split to occur. The sketch entity splits into two entities, and a split point is added between the two sketch entities.
