To modify the grid size, click "Edit Grid" in the bottom right hand corner of the **workplane**. You can then enter the width and height of **the** new grid that you would like to use.

Also, how do you move the camera in Tinkercad? This is a necessary technique for placing objects on irregular or curving shapes, but it also makes quick work of stacking common shapes. To reset **the workplane** back to its default location, simply drag a new workplane back to the original location.

The align tool is located in the upper right corner in the adjust menu.

To move an object up on the Z axis, hold CTRL and use the up and down arrow keys.

How do I resize a component in Tinkercad?

In Tinkercad, you can resize an object in any direction you like by dragging its corners. Unfortunately, youâ€™ll also disrupt its proportions (your perfect circle is now an oval). By holding the shift key as you drag, the object will hold its proportions as it scales up and down in the direction you pull it.

What is the default size of the Workplane in Tinkercad?

The Presets menu allows you to change the size of the workplane. Default is 200Ã—200 mm.

How do you drag view in Tinkercad?

MOVE THE WORKPLANE up and down and side to side â€” hold down the roller and move the mouse. such as Group â€” left click. shape â€” hold down left side of the mouse and drag it. ORBIT THE WORKPLANE to rotate the screen to view your design from different angles â€” hold down right side of the mouse and move the mouse.

What button do we use on the mouse to rotate the Workplane *?

To rotate the view of the workplane, hold the right mouse button and rotate your mouse. The scroll wheel can be used to zoom in/out on an area of the workplane.

How do you change the view in Tinkercad?

Thereâ€™s a button in Tinkercad that can change the 3D view of your design to a flatter â€œorthogonalâ€• view. Compared to the default 3D-like appearance of the â€œperspectiveâ€• view, orthogonal offers a more natural, birds-eye look at your model. To return to the default view, simply press the button again to toggle back.

How do you use the Workplane tool in TinkerCAD?

By pressing the the W key in Tinkercad (or selecting the workplane icon), you can define a new workplane on the surface of an object. Itâ€™s a handy way to add objects flush against the surface of your design (shapes, text, holes).
