1. In SketchUp, select Extensions > Extension Warehouse and sign in to the Extension Warehouse.
2. Select My Extensions from the user menu.
3. You can uninstall all your extensions in one move by clicking Uninstall All in the top right of the My Extensions tab.

The latest Cleanup Plugin is V3. 4.3, the main feature of Cleanup Plugin is to clean the sketchup file by deleting hidden or unused objects. The plugin is easy to use, you install the plugin as usual, set it up once, and next time use it with just one click.

Quick Answer, where are **plugins** in SketchUp? In **SketchUp**, select Extensions > Extension Manager. The Extension Manager window appears. Click the Install Extension button.

## Where is SketchUp 2021 plugin folder?

By default, we install the ruby files in your ProgramData folder: C:\ProgramData\SketchUp\SketchUp 2021\SketchUpPlugins Note: On your machine, the "ProgramData" folder may be spelled differently for your version of Windows.

Yes, SketchUp extensions are safe as long as you download them from a reputable source. SketchUp is a very popular 3D modeling program that allows users to create 3D models of anything they can imagine.

## What is RBZ file?

An RBZ file is a plugin used by Trimble SketchUp, a 3D modeling program used for computer-aided design (CAD). It stores one or more Ruby scripts (.RB files) compressed with .ZIP compression. RBZ files help reduce the size of SketchUp plugins when distributing and installing them.

## What is VRAY for SketchUp?

V-Ray® for SketchUp is an integral rendering solution for SketchUp, enabling designers to experience their designs in real-time as they model and take them to photorealism without leaving SketchUp. Preferred by many 3D artists, it is used by 95% of the top AEC firms worldwide.

## How do I enable VRAY in SketchUp?

1. Download the V-Ray for SketchUp installer, available [here](#).

2. Locate the installer and double-click to launch, EXE.
3. Please review the license agreement and click Next for your installation options.
4. Youâ€™re prompted for the version of SketchUp youâ€™re using, choose â€œSketchUp 2021â€
  - and click Install.

## How do I remove duplicates in Sketchup?

Manually you could window-select around a component while having â€œEntity Infoâ€™ open. Once you see (say) 11 instances, but seemingly only one selected, [Shift]click once on the selection again to reduce the number of selected instances to 10. Only then hit [Delete].

## How do I get rid of triangulation in Sketchup?

1. Step 1: Create a Morph.
2. Step 2: Change the Morph Settings.
3. Step 3: Changing Materials.

## What does coplanar mean in Sketchup?

Coplanar means â€œon the same planeâ€. So: if face1. plane == face2.

## How do I reduce the size of a Sketchup file?

1. Default Tray > Components. If you go to the default tray on the righthand side of your screen, you will notice a â€œcomponentsâ€ tab.
2. SAVE A COPY AS! Before continuing, make sure you save a copy of your original Sketchup file!
3. Window > Model Info > Statistics.
4. Purge Unused.

## How do you merge surfaces in Sketchup?

Select the Join tool ( ), which you find on the default toolbar or by selecting Tools > Join. Click an edge in each piece with the Join tool cursor. A blue outline flashes as you click, and the shape begins to inherit the fill color of the first shape that you click.

## How do I install sketch Plugins?

1. Click on the plugin youâ€™d like to install and you will be directed to a Github repository.
2. Click on the green â€™clone or download buttonâ€™ and click on â€™download zipâ€™ from the dropdown.
3. You will receive a message that the plugin was installed.

## Where do I put RBZ files in SketchUp?

1. Locate the RBZ file that you downloaded. It will usually be found in your â€™Downloadsâ€™ folder.
2. Select the RBZ file.
3. Click â€™Openâ€™

## Where is the SketchUp folder?

The folder path of your SketchUp library is listed in the Library Location field. Click Browse to set your library folder. Navigate to your library folder, then click Save. The folder path you chose should now appear in the Library Location field.

## How do I approve unidentified extensions in SketchUp?

There are three extension policy modes: â€™Identified Extensions Onlyâ€™, â€™Approve Unidentified Extensionsâ€™, and â€™Unrestrictedâ€™. To access these settings, select Window > Extension Manager > Gear icon ( ) > More Info icon ( ).

## Why is my SketchUp extension unsigned?

An extension may be unsigned if you installed it manually. Tip: Download the most recent version of any extension you use from the Extension Warehouse, the author, or the original trusted download source.

## How do I convert RB to RBZ?

If you prefer the RBZ way, you can always right click on an RB file and send it to a ZIP file then rename the ZIP extension to RBZ and you can use the preferences installing way. Similarly, if you have a ZIPâ€™ed plugin already, just rename the extension.
