## Introduction

To turn off the background mask, double-click the text to go back into the Multiline Text Editor and click the Background Mask button. In the Background Mask dialog, clear the Use **background** mask checkbox, and then click OK.

People ask also, how do I get rid of text mask in **AutoCAD**? To **remove** text mask Select Express > Text > Unmask **Text**.

In this regard, how do I hide objects behind **text** in AutoCAD?

1. On the Ribbon, go to Home tab > Expand Annotation drop-down > Dimension styles manager.
2. Select the Dimension style to change and click Modify.
3. Go to **Text** tab > Text appearance.
4. From the Fill color drop-down, choose **Background**.
5. Confirm all windows with OK.

Similarly, how do you change the transparency of **text** in **AutoCAD**? Click Home tab Layers Panel Layer Properties Find. In the Layer Properties Manager, under the Transparency column, click the transparency setting that you want to change.

Amazingly, how do I remove the hatch behind text in AutoCAD?

1. In the Conversation pane or the Preview pane of an Interaction, right-click the Message and select Show Message. The Message window is displayed.
2. In the Content tab, select the masked text.
3. Right-click and select Unmask Selected from the shortcut menu.

## What is isolate object in AutoCAD?

Hiding and Isolating Objects. You can use object visibility tools to control the visibility of objects independent from layer visibility. These tools enable you to hide selected objects so that they become invisible or isolate objects so that only the selected objects remain visible in the drawing.

## How do I make background transparent in AutoCAD?

Right-click the image. Click Properties. In the Properties palette, select Transparency. Click the down arrow at the right of the box and select Yes.

## How do I make a background transparent in AutoCAD?

1. Select the image.
2. Right-click the image.
3. In the Properties palette, select Transparency.
4. Click the down arrow at the right of the box and select Yes.

## How do I remove fill color in AutoCAD?

1. Set Fill Mode to 0 to turn off the fill mode. This turns off the display of solid fills.
2. Set Fill Mode to 1 to turn on the fill mode. This turns on the display of solid fills.
3. At the Command prompt, enter regen to regenerate the drawing, updating the display.

## Why is there a box around my text in AutoCAD?

Make sure the "Properties" dialogue is in the working area, if not press "CTRL + 1" to display. Select the text, at the bottom of the "Text" panel in the "Properties" dialogue there is the option "Frame text" which by default is set to "No" change this to "Yes" to

frame the text.

## How do I remove hatching?

1. Double-click the hatch pattern (not the hatch boundary).
2. The Hatch Editor will open. Click Pick Points.
3. Type S in the Command line and press Enter.
4. The cursor will turn into a pickbox. Select each of the internal areas where you want to remove the hatch.

## How do I remove a hatch in AutoCAD?

Click on the hatch. In the hatch ribbon click off the associative button, then on the left off the ribbon pick the select command. Click on the small square polyline that you want to remove the hatch in, hit enter. That should remove it.

## How do you create a mask in AutoCAD?

1. Click Annotate tab Markup panel Wipeout. Find.
2. Specify points in a sequence that defines the perimeter of the area to be masked. You can also enter p and click an existing polyline to use. The polyline must be closed, contain line segments only, and have zero width.
3. Press Enter to end the command.

## How do you remove mask labels?

Any kind of cooking oil will work – olive oil, canola oil, or vegetable oil. Submerge the plastic in cooking oil for 12-24 hours. The oil will soak into the adhesive and make it easier to remove sticker residue. Use baking soda and cooking oil or water.

## How do you outline text in AutoCAD?

1. Open your AutoCAD project and click – Express Tools – in the menu.
2. Click the – Modify Text – drop-down menu in the toolbar and select – Explode. –
3. Click the text that you want to change into polylines.
4. Press – Enter – on your keyboard to convert the text to polylines.

## How do you use wipeout in AutoCAD?

1. On the ribbon, choose Annotate > Wipeout (in Markup).
2. On the menu, choose Draw > Wipeout.
3. On the Draw toolbar, click the Wipeout tool.
4. Type wipeout and then press Enter.
5. "Yes" Creates the wipeout and deletes the polyline used to create the wipeout.

## How do you isolate all blocks in AutoCAD?

From drawing select components which you want to keep in drawing then right click to bring the contextual menu. From this menu select isolate then isolate objects. All the objects from the drawing will disappear leaving only drawing objects which you have selected, now you have a clutter free drawing to work with.

## How do you use an isolate layer in AutoCAD?

Press the CTRL key and then in the Layer Properties Manager, select those two layers. Then, right-click to display the shortcut menu and choose Isolate Selected Layers. As soon as you do, the FURNITURE and R-CEILING layers are no longer visible.
