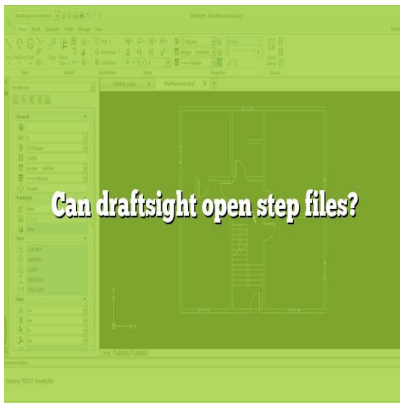




Can draftsight open step files?

1. Open your 3D file.
2. Go to File â†’ Save as.
3. In the opened window, specify the output file name and file format (AutoCAD DWG or DXF).
4. Click Save.

Also the question is, how do I convert DraftSight to Solidworks?

1. Select the Drawing View in SolidWorks.
2. Edit (drop-down menu) -> Copy to DWG Format.
3. Go to **Draftsight**.
4. Edit (drop-down menu) -> Paste.
5. Left Click to Paste the View into **Draftsight**.

Best answer for this question, how do I create a DXF file in **DraftSight**?

1. Type ExportDXF.
2. In the dialog box, specify the following: Save in: Navigate to the folder where you want to store the file. File name: Type a name for the file. Save as type: Select a . dxf type.
3. Click Save.

How do I export from DraftSight?

1. Click File > Export > Export (or type Export).
2. In the dialog box, specify the following: Navigate to the folder where you want to store the file. Type a name for the file. Select a file type for exporting.
3. Click Save.

How do I view a STEP file?

1. Find the STEP file on your computer or device.
2. Double click or right-click and select File > Open.
3. Your file will open with the associated STEP reading software already installed, like Adobe Acrobat.

How do I convert STP to PDF?

Open your. Stp file with a reader which can open the file. Print the file on the virtual PDF24 PDF printer. The PDF24 assistant opens, where you can save as a PDF, email, fax, or edit the new file.

How do I export HomeByMe?

1. Access HomeByMe by: Opening www.HomeByMe.com in a web browser.
2. Log into HomeByMe.
3. Click My projects and select a project. HomeByMe loads the project.
4. On the project page, click Export on the top next to Save.
5. In the Export As A DraftSight File dialog box, click Download.

How do I extract a sheet in AutoCAD?

1. Choose File→Save As.
2. From the Save As Type list, select the AutoCAD document format you want to save to: *. dxf or *.
3. Click Options.
4. On the first page of the Solid Edge to AutoCAD Translation Wizard, click Next.
5. Under Sheet Options, select one of the following:
6. Click Finish.

How do I export a drawing in AutoCAD?

1. On [File] menu, click [Export] → [Export to DXF File] / [Export to DWG File]. [Export] dialog box will be displayed.
2. Select a saving location.
3. Enter a file name in [File Name] box.
4. Click [Save] button. The drawing created in RootPro CAD will be saved as an AutoCAD drawing file.

How do I convert a STEP file?

Doing so is a very simple process. Open up the file using Onshape, and once inside, select the object, right-click anywhere on the viewport and select →Export→. Once there, simply choose the file format as STL, and now you can convert STEP to STL files, offline, for free!
