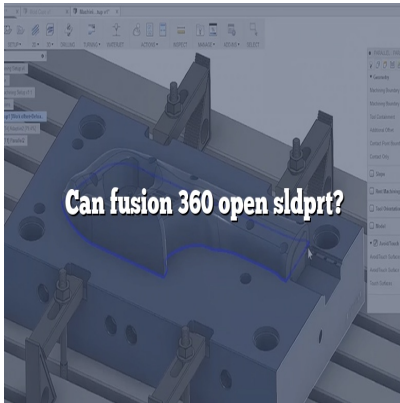




Can fusion 360 open sldprt?

Subsequently, can I use SolidWorks files in Fusion 360? After hitting the "Upload" button, the top-level assembly file will appear on the **Fusion** 360 Data Panel and will be able to access and edit a copy of the SOLIDWORKS assembly in Fusion 360.

Also the question is, can you import SolidWorks into fusion? Click the upload button to **open** the Upload dialog box, this will then give us the option to Select the files which we would like to use or Drag and Drop then files into the dialog box. The files will then be located in the "Solidworks Files" folder we have created. How to open an **SLDPRT** file. You can open an **SLDPRT** file in Dassault Systemes SolidWorks, Dassault Systemes SolidWorks eDrawings Viewer, or Autodesk Fusion 360. Note that if you **open** an **SLDPRT** file in SolidWorks eDrawings Viewer, you can only view the file's contents, not edit them.

What files does Fusion 360 support?

1. Autodesk Inventor (.ipt)
2. STEP (.step)
3. OBJ (.obj)
4. STL (.stl)
5. Solidworks (.sldprt)

What file extension is Sldprt?

An SLDPRT file is a CAD file generated by SolidWorks software. It is a 3D file format that contains the 3D information of an object or "part". Multiple SLDPRT files having compatible parts can be combined to create a single SLDASM assembly file. SLDPRT files can be opened using SmartCAM CAD/CAM Software by SolidWorks.

Which is better Fusion 360 or SolidWorks?

Fusion 360 is cloud-based and works on both Windows and Mac while SOLIDWORKS is purely Windows-based with cloud storage options. Fusion 360 has basic analysis and simulation tools, while SOLIDWORKS' analysis and simulation features are much more comprehensive. Fusion 360 has decent sculpt tools while SOLIDWORKS doesn't.

How do you convert Sldprt to STL?

It may seem obvious, but the easiest and most reliable way to convert SLDPRT to STL is with SolidWorks. It's a simple and fast process – you just have to open your SLDPRT file in SolidWorks, click on "Save as" in the "File" menu, choose "STL file format," and save it.

Accepted answer. Use GrabCAD Workbench. Upload your sldprt file to workbench then you can right click on the uploaded file and select "Download as". You can download the file in the format of STEP, IGES, STL, Parasolid, ACIS, JT, or VRML.
