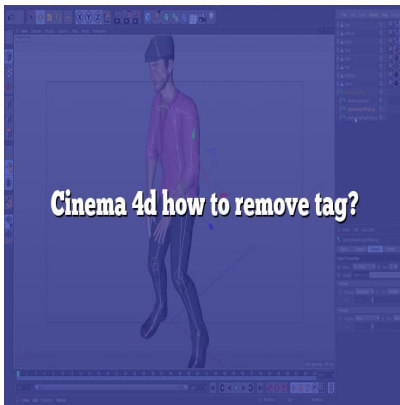

As many you asked, how do I add a selection tag in Cinema 4d? Brian Jones. You’re adding to a selection tag, yes? Select the Selection Tag hit Restore Selection add your windows to the selection, then with the selection **tag** still selected choose Set Selection again.

Quick Answer, how do you replace material? In the Object Material Slots box, click the Plus to create a new slot, and while this is still active, click on the second material in the Available Materials list. Click the Assign button, and the second material will appear on the selected object faces.

There are two areas in CINEMA 4D where you can adjust the materials, the Attribute Editor or the Material Editor. At the bottom of the timeline you should see the material manager, this displays any of the shaders you currently have in your scene.

Why use composites? The greatest advantage of composite materials is strength and stiffness combined with lightness. By choosing an appropriate combination of reinforcement and matrix material, manufacturers can produce properties that exactly fit the requirements for a particular structure for a particular purpose.

Why is composite better than conventional material?

Composites have a high strength-to-weight ratio. Perhaps the biggest advantage of composites is their high strength-to-weight ratio. Carbon fiber weighs about 25% as much as steel and 70% as much as aluminum, and is much stronger and stiffer than both materials per weight.

Why have plastics replaced traditional materials?

There's nothing new about plastic as a substitute for other materials. From its very beginnings, plastic took the place of whalebone, tortoiseshell, wood, and stone. The reasons for substitution were simple: availability and cost.
