Which is better AutoCAD or Revit?

What does Revit stand for?

The ease of making changes inspired the name Revit, a contraction of Revise-Instantly. At the heart of Revit is a parametric change propagation engine that relied on a new technology, context-driven parametrics, that was more scalable than the variational and history-driven parametrics used in mechanical CAD software.

What is the difference between Revit LT and Revit?

While “full” Revit is BIM (building information modeling) software designed for a multidiscipline, collaborative design process and includes features for architectural design, MEP and structural engineering, and construction, Revit LT was derived from Revit software as a stepping stone for smaller architectural design “

How does Revit different from AutoCAD?

While AutoCAD is a general drawing tool with broad application, Revit is a design and documentation solution, supporting all phases and disciplines involved in a building project. Revit is used to coordinate all data inputs (including CAD) and produce federated project deliverables.

Can I learn Revit in a day?

It takes somewhere between 40 hours to several years to learn Revit. Yes, that’s a HUGE range, but it really depends on what your background is, and what you’re trying to do with it.

Is ArchiCAD or Revit better?

Winner: Revit. When it comes to massing, Revit can produce complex shapes and models, while ArchiCAD is a little simpler, so it tends to have less capability. When it comes to Nesting, Revit's complexity allows a user to create unique materials and objects to suit their specific needs.

Is Revit worth learning?

Revit is the backbone of most modern Building Information Modelling (BIM) workflows for building design, construction and owner data. Not every project needs BIM. For building projects that would benefit from BIM at one or more stages in their lifecycle, then it is almost definitely worth it.
