Introduction

Right click on the **text** > Go to Editor settings > Text Highlight Color (Enable).

Best answer for this question, how do you color something in **AutoCAD**? Right-click in the drawing area, and choose Properties. In the Properties palette, click Color, and then click the down arrow. From the drop-down list, choose the color that you want to assign to the objects. Press Esc to remove the selection.

Quick Answer, how do you highlight a selection in **AutoCAD**?

Also, can you **highlight** in AutoCAD? Selection preview in AutoCAD temporarily highlights objects so you can easily identify the correct ones before actually selecting them.

You asked, how do you highlight text? How to **highlight text** using your keyboard. To highlight with the keyboard, move to the starting location using the arrow keys. Then, hold down the Shift key, and press the arrow key in the direction you want to **highlight**. Once everything you want is highlighted, let go of the Shift key. Click the Text tab. In the **Text** color list, select a color for text. In the Text height box, type the new text height. Click OK until all dialog boxes close.

How do I add background color to text in AutoCAD?

You can easily add a background mask to the text. Double-click the text to begin editing the text. Then, in the Style panel of the Text Editor contextual ribbon, click the Background Mask button. The program displays the Background Mask dialog.

Why can't I select lines in AutoCAD?

There might be several causes for this: The desired objects are within a viewport on a layout and the viewport is not active. The layer of the objects are locked. The edit mode of an xref is active.

What are the selection commands in AutoCAD?

You can select object using a line or a fence. When prompted to select objects, type [F] for fence and simply draw a dashed line across objects you want to select. All crossed and touched objects will be selected. If you made a mistake and selected an object you don't need, don't cancel command and start over.

How do you add highlights in AutoCAD?

Right click on the text > Go to Editor settings > Text Highlight Color (Enable).

How do I change the highlight color in AutoCAD?

Starting with AutoCAD 2016, you can also change the color of the highlight by using the SELECTIONEFFECTCOLOR system variable.

What is Loft command?

The loft command in AutoCAD is used to create 3D solid or surface. The 3D solid or surface is formed within the space between various cross sections. The cross-sections determine the outer shape of the solid or surface. To create a 3D object using LOFT, we are required to specify at least two cross-sections.

How do you apply highlighter?

How do I highlight text selectively?

1. Select the first item that you want. For example, select some text.
2. Press and hold CTRL.

3. Select the next item that you want. Important Be sure to press and hold CTRL while you select the next item that you want to include in the selection.

What is the shortcut key for highlighting text?

Using the highlighting shortcut key Adding highlighting: Select the text you want to highlight, then press Ctrl+Alt+H. Removing highlighting: Select the highlighted text, then press Ctrl+Alt+H.

How do I change the color of text in AutoCAD 2018?

How do I underline text in AutoCAD 2018?

1. Select "Multiline Text" from the "Text" drop-down menu and create one box in the workspace where you want to write.
2. Write something as you needed.
3. Just double-click on the text.
4. Select text and click on the "U" (Underline) from the "Formatting" panel.

How do I make text background opaque in AutoCAD?

In the Type Properties window which should now be on screen, select the Text type from the drop down list or create a new one. Then under Graphics "Background", click Opaque and switch it to Transparent.

What is a wipeout in AutoCAD?

The Wipeout command is used to hide some parts of the drawing without deleting them. It is an object of the background color, the borders of which have a different color and can be hidden.

How do I change the color of my text Mask in AutoCAD?
