2. Collapse transform. Animation created with vector layers allows you to scale without losing quality.

- 1. Click the Stopwatch icon next to the property name to activate it. After Effects creates a keyframe at the current time for that property value.
- 2. Choose Animation > Add [x] Keyframe, where [x] is the name of the property you are animating.

# How do you free transform an animation?

- 1. To move the selection, position the pointer over the object within the bounding box, and drag the object to a new position.
- 2. To set the center of rotation or scaling, drag the transformation point to a new location.

#### How can we scale the object in a single direction in Flash?

In the Tools panel, select the Scale modifier. Position the pointer over a handle. The pointer changes to a double-headed arrow, indicating the direction in which the element will grow or shrink as you drag the handles inward or outward.
