2. Select the plus sign wherever you want to add a learning module.
3. To select whether students will view the learning module's content in sequence, select Conditional availability in the module's visibility menu.

1. In Edit Mode, on the Course Menu, click an existing Content Area or create a new one.
2. On the Content Area's Action Bar, point to Build Content to access the drop-down list.
3. Select **Learning Module**.
4. On the **Create Learning Module** page, type in a Name.

Also know, how do I add a module to Blackboard? Add a course module page Select the Add Menu Item icon above the course menu to access the menu. Select Module Page and type a name. Select the Available to Users check box if you're ready for students to see it. After you submit, a link to the new module page appears at the bottom of the course menu.

What is a self learning module?

Self-learning modules (SLMs) are a systematic set of instructions that facilitate learners'™ mastery of a body of knowledge or a complex process (Maile & Cooper, 2018) and are designed where the learner is free to choose what to learn, how to learn, when to learn and where to learn (Sequeira, 2012) .

How do you create a content module?

1. Click on the Content tab in your NavBar.
2. Under Table of Contents, enter a module name in the Add a Module field found at the bottom.
3. Drag the reorder icon to the left of the module title to move them up or down the list.

1. Thinkific: Software to create an online course for free.
2. Canva: Free and low-cost design tool.
3. Beaver Builder: affordable WordPress page builder.
4. Camtasia: Cheap software for editing online course videos, with a free trial.
5. Vimeo: Free video hosting.

What is an interactive module?

Interactive learning modules (ILM™s) are small web applications which provide an environment where students interact with the learning activity and learn by watching the animation or visual information.

1. Include Supplemental Links For Self-Guided Exploration.

3. Use Real-World Visuals And Sounds.
4. Turn It Into An Online Training Scenario Or Simulation.
5. Gamify Your Online Training Tutorial.
6. Include A Closed-Ended Question.
