2. In the Format Shape dialog box, click the Fill tab.
3. In the Fill pane, select Pattern fill and then select a pattern, foreground color, and background color for your pattern fill.

1. Select the Offset tool () or press the F key.
2. Click one of your selected line segments or the face you want to offset.
3. Move the cursor to define the offset dimension.
4. Move the cursor to define the offset dimension.
5. Click to finish the offset.

How do you make a shape smooth in SketchUp?

| Windows: Select Window > Default Tray > Soften Edges. Or context-click your selection and choose Soften/Smooth Edges. Either way, the Soften Edges dialog box appears, as shown in the figure. Click

and drag the Angle between normals slider to set the maximum size of all angles that will be smoothed or softened.

For example, perhaps you're a graphic designer who needs to outline a complex shape or an architect who needs to offset a footer in a foundation plan. Either way, the Offset tool can create the shape you need in only two clicks.

A full-color pattern fill (also known as a "vector pattern") is a more complex vector graphic that can be composed of lines and fills. A full-color fill can have color or transparent background. A bitmap pattern fill is a bitmap image whose complexity is determined by its size, image resolution, and bit depth.
