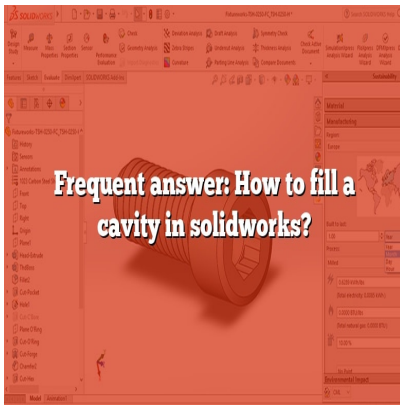

Also, how do you fill a hollow part in Solidworks? To create a filled surface, click Filled Surface on the Surfaces toolbar, or click Insert > Surface > Fill, set the PropertyManager options, and click OK .

Additionally, how do I edit a **cavity** in **Solidworks**?

1. Optional: Insert the design parts and the mold base into an interim assembly.
2. In the assembly window, select the mold base, and click Edit Component on the Assembly toolbar.
3. Click Cavity on the Mold Tools toolbar, or click Insert > Mold > Cavity.

1. Right-click the component in the graphics area or the component's name in the FeatureManager design tree.
 2. Select Fix or Float.
 3. In assemblies with multiple configurations, select This Configuration, All Configurations, or Specified Configurations.

1. Optional: Insert the design parts and the mold base into an interim assembly.
 2. In the assembly window, select the mold base, and click Edit Component on the Assembly toolbar.
 3. Click Cavity on the Mold Tools toolbar, or click Insert > Mold > Cavity.

How do I fill an assembly in SolidWorks?

1. Check Subtract.
2. Choose the Boss-Extrude as the main body.
3. Combine with the Join Body.

How do I make my surface solid solidworks?

To convert a boundary surface into a solid, click Insert > Surface > Boundary Surface, and in Options and Preview, click Create solid. To convert a trim-surface feature into a solid, click Insert > Surface > Trim Surface and in Surface Split Options, click Create solid.

How do you merge features in Solidworks?

1. Click Combine. (Features toolbar) or Insert > Features > Combine.
2. In the PropertyManager, under Operation Type, select Add.
3. For Bodies to Combine, select the bodies to combine. You can select bodies in the graphics area or the Solid Bodies.
4. Click Show Preview to preview the feature.
5. Click .

Why can't I combine in Solidworks?

You can only combine bodies contained within one multibody part file. You cannot combine two separate parts. However, you can create a multibody part by using Insert Part to place one part into the other part file. Then you can use Combine on the multibody part.

How do you get a cavity?

Cavities are permanently damaged areas in the hard surface of your teeth that develop into tiny openings or holes. Cavities, also called tooth decay or caries, are caused by a combination of factors, including bacteria in your mouth, frequent snacking, sipping sugary drinks and not cleaning your teeth well.

How do you make a cavity mold?

How do I ground a part in SOLIDWORKS?

1. In an assembly, click Insert > Reference Geometry > Ground Plane.
2. In the PropertyManager, in Ground Plane, select a face in the assembly.
3. (Optional.) Click Reverse Direction , or click the handle in the graphics area.
4. Click . Ground Plane appears in the FeatureManager design tree.

How do I rebuild a part in SOLIDWORKS?

To rebuild the model: Click Rebuild (Standard toolbar) or Edit > Rebuild, or press Ctrl + B. Rebuilds only the features that changed since the last rebuild. To rebuild all features, press Ctrl + Q.

How do you Unfix a part in an assembly in SOLIDWORKS?

To unfix a component(s), right click on them and select "Float". Moving a component within fully constrained assembly will move the entire assembly. Any components, that have not been fully constrained, may appear out of position.

How do I make a mold design?

How do you make a negative part in Solidworks?

1. Click Combine. (Features toolbar) or Insert > Features > Combine.
2. In the PropertyManager, under Operation Type, select Subtract.
3. For Main Body, select the body to keep.
4. For Bodies to Subtract, select the bodies whose material you want to remove.
5. Click Show Preview to preview the feature.
6. Click .

How do I fill a circle in SolidWorks?

What is filled surface in SolidWorks?

The Filled Surface feature constructs a surface patch with any number of sides, within a boundary defined by existing model edges, sketches, or curves, including composite curves. You can use this feature to construct a surface to fill a gap in a model.

How do I fill text in a SolidWorks drawing?

1. Click a face of a part.
2. Click Text.
3. In the graphics area, select an edge, curve, sketch, or sketch segment.
4. In the PropertyManager, under Text, type the text to display.
5. Set the properties in the Sketch Text PropertyManager as necessary.
6. Click .
7. With the sketch still open, extrude or cut the text.
