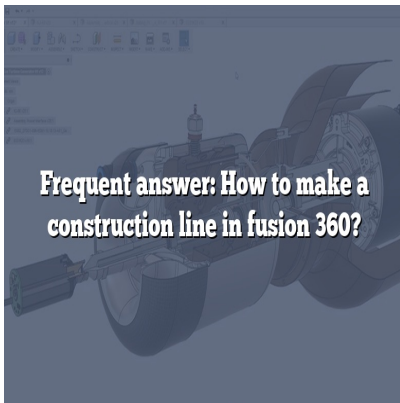

1. Click Home tab Draw panel Construction **Line**. Find.
2. Specify a point to define the root of the construction **line**.
3. Specify a second point through which the **construction line** should pass.
4. Continue to specify construction lines as needed.
5. Press Enter to end the command.

Considering this, how do you add a **construction** line in CAD?

1. Click on the Construction **Line** icon, as shown in the below image: Or. Type XL on the command line and press Enter.
2. Type A on the command line or command prompt and press Enter. Or. Select Ang option on the command line.

3. Specify the angle of XLine (Construction line). For example, 30.

Quick Answer, where is the line tool in Fusion 360? The Line tool in the Sketch > Create panel lets you create a connected series of lines and arcs as sketch geometry or **construction** geometry in an active sketch in Fusion 360. You can use the following command to create lines in an active sketch: **Line**. Step 2: You can find the construction **line** command from the Draw menu of the Home tab of this software with this type of line icon. Step 3: Or you can use short cut command for the construction line, which is type XL, then press enter button of the keyboard and your command will be active.

What is a Xline in Civil 3d?

XLIN: Draws a line of infinite length. We can draw it free or set it to be horizontal, vertical, follow a certain angle, be the bisector of an angle or be parallel to certain line.

What is the difference between a ray and Xline?

A construction line (also known as an xline) is a linear object that passes through two points and extends to infinity in both directions. A ray is a linear object starts at a point, passes through a second point, and extends to infinity.

How do I draw a horizontal line in AutoCAD?

Point [Line] on [Shape] menu, and click [Horizontal Line]. Then you will be able to create a horizontal line. You can enter into the horizontal line creating status by clicking on [Shape] toolbar. Click the start point of a horizontal line on the drawing.

How do you curve a straight line in Fusion 360?

How do you make a sketch in Fusion 360?

1. Select the Solid tab in the Design workspace. Select Create Sketch in the toolbar.
2. Select the initial plane or face to begin the sketch on.
3. Check the 3D Sketch box in the Sketch Palette.

How do you draw freehand in Fusion 360?

What shortcut key changes a line to from construction geometry in Fusion 360?

To do so, simply hold down the shift key and select all the lines that you want to change. Then you can hit the keyboard shortcut letter "X" or select "construction" in the Sketch dialog box. You'll notice that construction lines are signified by dashed lines.

How do I change the view to isometric (like Sketchup)? Thanks. Switch to Orthographic View under Display Settings and then use the corners of faces of the View Cube to set your scene as you like. By clicking on the corner of the View Cube you can get the 120 by 120 by 120 degree view.

Find. Construction lines (also known as xlines) are temporary linework entities that can be used as references when creating and positioning other objects or linework. Construction lines are either circles or straight lines that extend to infinity in both directions. The following prompts are displayed.

What is a polyline in CAD?

A polyline is a connected sequence of line segments created as a single object. You can create straight line segments, arc segments, or a combination of the two.

How do you make an infinite line in AutoCAD?

Creates a construction line of infinite length. Xlines are useful for creating construction and reference lines, and for trimming boundaries.
