Frequent question, how do you tag a legend component in **Revit**?

1. Click the chart to which you want to add a **legend**, click the Chart Elements button. , and then click **Legend**.
2. To change the location of the **legend**, click the arrow next to Legend and then click the location that you want.

What are legends used for in Revit?

Legend views list model components and annotations used in a project.

How do you edit a legend in Revit?

1. Open a legend view.
2. Select a legend component, and on the Properties Palette, specify the view direction, host length (if applicable), detail level, and component type. By default, the legend component acquires its detail level from the project view.

How do I make a keynote legend in Revit?

Add a keynote legend to a view to provide details of keynotes assigned to elements or materials in the view. You can access the Keynote Legend tool by clicking View tab Create panel Legends drop-down (Keynote Legend). There are 2 parameters predefined in the Scheduled fields list: Key Value and

Keynote Text.

How do you create a key in Revit?

1. Click View tab Create panel Schedules drop-down Schedule/Quantities.
2. In the New Schedule dialog, select the element category for which you want to schedule keys.
3. Select Schedule keys.
4. Click OK.
5. In the Schedule Properties dialog, add the predefined fields for the style.
6. Click OK.

How do I save a schedule as a template?

1. Click Scheduler.
2. Create a daily or weekly schedule that you'd like to use again in the future.
3. Click the wrench icon, then click Save As New Template.
4. Enter a name for the template. The description is optional.
5. Click Save Template to save the template.

How do I arrange a schedule in Revit?

To list every instance of the family and type in a schedule, on the Sorting/Grouping tab of the Schedule Properties dialog, use the following settings: Sort by = Family and Type (Ascending, Blank line) Itemize every instance = on.

How do I add a header to a Revit schedule?

1. Open a schedule view.
2. In the group header rows, drag the cursor across the headings to group.
3. Click Modify Schedule/Quantities tab Headers panel Group, or right-click the selected headings, and click Group Headers.
4. Enter text in the new row as necessary.

How do I make a color fill a legend in Revit?

1. Open a floor plan view or section view.
2. Click Annotate tab Color Fill panel (Legend).
3. Click in the drawing area to place the color fill legend.
4. In the Choose Space Type and Color Scheme dialog, select the space type and color scheme, and click OK.

How do you add a legend in GIS?

1. If necessary, click the Layer options button. on the map toolbar to display the map layers.
2. Expand a layer. to view the Layer options pane.
3. On the Legend tab , click the Pop out legend button . A legend card is added to the page.

How do I create a custom legend in Arcmap?

Open the layout. On the Insert tab of the ribbon, click Legend. Draw a box next to the map to add a legend.

What is a sheet legend?

1. With a chart, a legend is an area of a chart describing each of the parts of the chart. See our chart definition for a visual example of a legend. 2. A legend is an explanation of characters, symbols, or markings on a document that are usually unfamiliar to the reader.

How do you Create a floor finish legend in Revit?

1. New > Legends > Legend > Floor Finish Legend > OK.
2. From the project browser, navigate to Generic Models.
3. Drag Floor Type A to the legend.

How do I Create a material tag in Revit?

1. Click Annotate tab Tag panel (Material Tag).
2. On the Options Bar: To set the orientation of the tag, select Vertical or Horizontal.
3. Highlight the material to tag within the element, and click to place the tag.

What is keynote in Revit?

Keynote files are text files that define the categories and keynote values that you assign to element types, materials, and individual elements. About Editing the Keynote File. Keynotes are defined in a tab-delimited text file.

How do I add a keynote to a Revit sheet?

To add a keynote legend to your drawing sheet, drag and drop the legend "KEYNOTE LEGEND" (pre-created in the HCMA Template File) onto the applicable sheet. Keynote legends are smart in that they automatically update to display only the keynote information for the keynotes visible on that sheet.
