Introduction

Autocad has a new feature called Select Similar. The way it works is the user selects an element and then selects the option:select similar. This builds a selection set of all elements that share the same attributes: Level, cell name, etc.

Quick Answer, how do you select multiple elements in MicroStation?

- 1) Manual – Hold down the Control (CTRL) key on your keyboard and left click elements individually to select multiple elements.
- 2) By square region – drag a box around a series of elements to select everything within the box.

Considering this, where is Element Selection tool MicroStation?

You asked, what is element selection tool? Used to select and deselect elements for modification or manipulation. The set of selected elements is called the selection set . You can access this tool from the following: Ribbon: Drawing > Home > Selection.

Is there a match properties in MicroStation?

To match element attributes anytime “ even when you are already right in the middle of drawing an element. Press the “Alt”-key “ move your cursor to the element you want to match the attributes from “ left-mouse-click. The properties of the element become the active attributes.

How do you find duplicates in MicroStation?

1. Open MicroStation Menu Utilities > Data cleanup.
2. The Design File cleanup dialog is divided into 4 tabs with variable settings.
3. In General > Cleanup Actions choose Delete.
4. When activating the Apply button duplicates are searched and removed according to settings.
5. The number of deleted elements is displayed.

How do I select by attribute in MicroStation?

Select By Attributes “ Open the Select By Attributes dialog (effect is same as choosing Drawing > Home > Selection.

How do you select one level in MicroStation?

How do I find element information in MicroStation?

You can also review or modify MicroStation drawing information about an element(s), such as its type, attributes, and geometry, by using the Element Information dialog. To access the Element Information dialog, click the Element Information button or click the Element menu and select the Information command.

What is PopSet in MicroStation?

Introduced as a SELECT add-on application for MicroStation /J, PopSet manages the display of the Tool Settings dialog resulting in additional screen real estate and reduced mouse movement.

Where is key in MicroStation?

Go to Help>Contents pull-down menu. Once the help menu options click on “MicroStation V8i Help Keyin-in Index”. This will bring up the key-in index dialog with a listing of all MicroStation key-ins.

Key-in can also be searched on by using the "Find" field.

What will the quick selection tool do?

The Quick Selection tool is one of many selection tools in Photoshop. When you choose an area, Photoshop detects and selects the edges, so you don't have to trace them manually. This tool works great for photos with high contrast and well-defined edges.

How do I turn on handles in MicroStation?

In MicroStation, when an element is selected, handles appear. These handles can be used to stretch an element (object). To turn off and on handle display, use the Disable Edit Handles setting on the Preferences dialog box, Operation category (Workspace > Preferences).

What happens when you select an element in the model?

When you select an element: The element is outlined in the color specified in options. Any element-specific editing controls and dimensions display on or adjacent to the element. Applicable editing tools are available on the Modify | tab.

How do you match hatch pattern in MicroStation connect?

1. Create new element template.
2. Add>Pattern/Hatch Settings.
3. Change Area Pattern Is Annotation value to True(this should be the default value)

How do I cross hatch in MicroStation?

How do I use the hatch area in MicroStation?

To hatch around text inside of a closed element use the Flood method, select the down arrow in the lower right corner of the Tool Settings window to "Show Extended Settings". Select the Locate Interior Text icon. Using this option will cause the hatching to go around the text within the closed element.

How do you match text in Microstation v8i?

Where is change attribute tool Microstation?

1. Select the elements required to be changed.

2. Choose the "Change Element Attributes"™ tool from the Ribbon (or popup menu)
3. In the Tool Settings dialog, place a checkmark(s) against the attribute to change and select the required Attribute.
