1. To group objects, select several objects or nodes in the Object Lister, click one of those items with the and choose Group from the menu.
2. To ungroup objects, select a group node in the Object Lister, click it with the and choose Ungroup from the menu.

In this regard, how do you separate parts in Fusion 360?

Also the question is, how do you un combine bodies in Fusion 360? Split Body is usually the only way to "un combine" a solid body. You can use a sketch or a surface body to split a solid body into two.

Considering this, how do you split a mesh body in Fusion 360?

1. Trim will cut the mesh at the plane and remove the remaining mesh.
2. Split Body will split the mesh into two separate meshes at the plane.

Also, how do you ungroup objects?

1. Select the group that you want to ungroup.
2. To ungroup shapes, pictures or other objects, go to Picture Tools or Drawing Tools > Format > Arrange > Group. , and then choose Ungroup.

How do you isolate in Fusion 360?

1. Do one of the following: In the CADmep toolbar, click the Isolate Selected Objects icon. . At the command line, type MASKVIEW, SHOWALL and press Enter.
2. Select the items you wish remain on the drawing.
3. Right click or press Enter to execute.
4. All un-selected items should now be removed from view.

How do you split a mesh into multiple parts?

1. In Object Mode, select the object you want to split.
2. Enter edit mode (press â††1 Tab) key.
3. Select the faces you want to separate from the mesh.
4. Press â€Pâ€™ key > Selection to separate the selection into a new object.
5. A popup will appear with the following options:

What is the shortcut to ungroup objects?

Group and ungroup To group objects together, just select the objects and press Ctrl+G. To ungroup, select the object and press Ctrl+Shift+G.

What is grouping and ungrouping?

Grouping is useful when you should rearrange or manage many components on the screen. Instead of having to drag multiple components, you can click once and select multiple items and move them at one time. Ungrouping is particularly important when editing imported images, such as maps.

What is grouping and ungrouping elements?

A grouped element is composed of several other elements. Grouped elements can be grouped into larger elements. You can also ungroup elements. You can also create subgroups within a group from the Layout window. A subgroup element is composed of other elements within the group.

How do you modify a body in Fusion 360?

You need to use the concept of “direct modeling”. Fusion 360 has some tools for that, as @TrippyLighting said above. In the MODIFY tab, there is a tool called “Press and Pull”, which makes dimension editing, for example. But you have other tools, like Delete, Move/Copy, Split Face or Body.

What is the difference between a body and a component in Fusion 360?

1. Components have their own origin planes, but bodies don't. A component is a position and motion independent part of an assembly within the Fusion 360 single design environment. For example, an entire design is the whole assembly design, and each part of the design is a component of the overall assembly.

How do you isolate layers from XREF?

By principle, it is not possible to show a single layer from an xref and hide (switch off) all other drawing layers (including the layer where the xref is inserted). By switching off (freezing) the xref insertion layer, you'll switch off the whole xref, regardless of the visibility of its individual layers.

How do you make multiple parts in Fusion 360?

1. Create a new file in Fusion 360.
2. Use the Insert into Current Design function to have all the designs that should appear in the drawing in one Fusion 360 model.
3. Save the new design.
4. Create a drawing.
5. Insert / edit new views for the desired effect.

What are the shortcut keys for Fusion 360?

1. Animate Workspace Commands. U.

2. CAM Workspace Commands. Ctrl + D | Command +D.
3. Canvas Selection. Ctrl + C | Command + C.
4. Drawing Workspace Commands. B.
5. Edit Form Commands. Alt + Drag.
6. Generative Design workspace. N.
7. Render Workspace Commands. A.
8. Sculpt Workspace Selection. Shift + Up Arrow.
