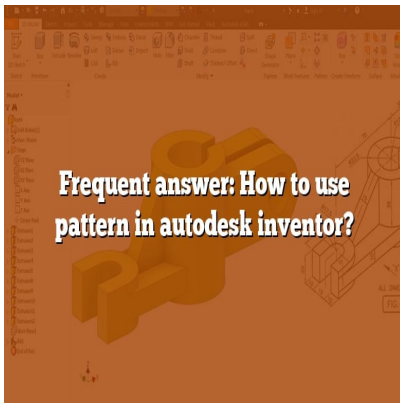

1. In the Mold Layout tab, click Pattern.
2. In the graphics window, select a plastic part.
3. In the **Pattern** dialog box, Circular tab, Pattern Type group, select the part orientation.
4. Base Pattern.
5. Enter the number of plastic parts.
6. Enter the rotation angle of the selected part.

Likewise, how do I edit a pattern in **Inventor**? Right-click a **pattern** element in the graphics window and choose Edit Pattern. Change any values in the Rectangular **Pattern** or Circular Pattern dialog box and click OK.

Moreover, what are circular patterns? **Use** circular patterns to create multiple instances of one or more features that you can space uniformly around an axis. **Pattern** instances inherit the feature color of the original feature when the: Pattern is based on one feature.

What is radial pattern?

A Radial Pattern arranges the specified features spaced along the circumference of a circle. The spacing can be set so you only arrange features along an arc instead of the whole circle. Spacing and angles are set with dimensions settings.

In the graphics window, click a face, surface, 2D sketch curve, work plane, or part body to define the intersection. Click one or more faces, surfaces, 2D sketch curves, or work planes to intersect. Click OK to create the curve.

How do you edit a sketch pattern?

To edit a sketch pattern: Right-click a pattern instance and select the appropriate Edit option. If you selected Display instance count, you can double-click the instance count and change it in the graphics area. Search “Editing Sketch Patterns”™ in the SOLIDWORKS Knowledge Base.

How do I create a constrain in Inventor?

The Constrain command is on the Assemble tab, in the Relationships panel. First, click the Constrain command and a window will pop up. There are 4 tabs: Assembly, Motion, Transitional, and Constraint Set. The one we will use first is the Assembly.

What is random pattern?

The setting of diamonds in a bit crown without regard to a geometric pattern—without regular and even spacing.

What is annular pattern?

A drainage pattern in which streams follow a roughly circular or concentric path along a belt of weak rock, resembling in plan a ringlike pattern.

What are the 4 types of drainage patterns?

These are dendritic, trellis, rectangular, and radial patterns.

How do you use a drill template?

The drill template has a few holes through which you can mark the spot where you want to drill for handles or knobs. Hold the drawer handle or knob against the template to determine its placement on the template and mark the spot with a pencil.

What is a drill template?

Drilling templates are reports of machining. They are output in the form of a PDF file, and contain an illustration of the items and drill holes that generate the items from a drilling pattern or, manually placed, on the basic item. The drill holes are dimensioned, and contain coordinate information.
