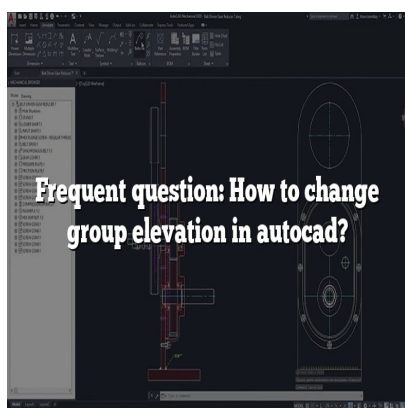

Introduction

In Civil 3D â†’ Toolspace â†’ Prospector Tab â†’ Expand Point Groups by clicking on the plus sign (+). Right click on the point **group** you would like to raise or lower.

Beside above, how do I change the **elevation** in **AutoCAD**?

1. Double-click the elevation line you want to relocate.
2. On the Properties palette, expand Basic Location.
3. Click Additional Information.
4. Specify the location of the **elevation** line: If you want toâ€¦ Thenâ€¦ relocate the elevation line.
5. Click OK.

Additionally, how do you change the **elevation** of a 3D polyline?

1. Click Modify tab Design panel Edit Polyline Elevations Find.

2. Select the polyline.
3. Specify the elevation. All vertices are assigned the same elevation.

Correspondingly, how do you change elevation units in Civil 3D?

1. Open Civil 3D.
2. Go to Settings tab right-click on drawing name and choose Edit Drawing Settings.
3. Un-check "Scale objects inserted from other drawings" and set drawing units to "Meters".
4. Click OK.
5. This will readjust elevation of inserted points.

As many you asked, how do you move points to **elevation** in Civil 3D? To **change** the elevation of points Right-click and click Datum. In response to the prompt, specify a **change** in elevation by doing one of the following: Enter a change in elevation.

1. Right-click the UCS icon, and click Z Axis.
2. Specify a point for the new origin (0,0,0).
3. Specify a point that lies on the positive Z axis.

How do I make elevation 0 in AutoCAD?

1. Type in the CHANGE command.
2. Type ALL to select all objects and then Enter.
3. Type P for Properties.
4. Type E for Elevation.
5. Type 0 and then a final Enter to end the command.

How do you assign elevations to polylines?

1. Location: ALL (or the Objects to be drawn)
2. Query Mode: DRAW.
3. Alter Properties: Elevation -> Expression -> select desired attribute from the table -> OK -> Add.
4. Execute Query.

How do you edit a 3D polyline in AutoCAD?

How do you make a 3D polyline with elevations from points?

1. Start 3D polyline command (command: "3DPOLY")
2. While still in command type "PO" ("Point Object" transparent command) in command-line.
3. Click the first point and then on any subsequent points to create the desired line.
4. Hit Enter key.

How do I change the decimal places in AutoCAD?

Type Units in the Command line and press Enter. In the Drawing Units dialog box, select your desired number of decimal places from the Precision menu. For example, select 0.00 if you want your units to appear with two decimal places. Click OK to save the change.

How do I change dimension precision in AutoCAD?

To Change the Precision of Dimensions (AutoCAD Mechanical Toolset) In the drawing area, select the dimensions you want to edit. The Power Dimensioning Ribbon Contextual Tab displays. In the adjacent box, specify the number of decimal points to round off to.

How do you find elevation in Civil 3D?

1. Click Annotate tab Labels & Tables panel Add Labels menu Surface Spot Elevations On Grid .
2. Follow the command line instructions to define the grid location and position.

Where is surface elevation in AutoCAD?

1. Make a point group with the points that you want to get the surface elevations.
2. Use "Ctrl A" within this point group to select all points.
3. Rt. Click, select "Elevations from Surface".

How do you adjust the datum in Civil 3D?

To change the elevation of points Right-click and click Datum. In response to the prompt, specify a change in elevation by doing one of the following: Enter a change in elevation. To specify a decrease in the elevation, use a minus sign (-) before the value.

What is a COGO point in Civil 3D?

The points created by AutoCAD Civil 3D are called Coordinate Geometry (COGO) points, which are very different from AutoCAD point nodes. AutoCAD point nodes have only coordinate data (XYZ values) associated with them.

How do I get rid of XYZ in AutoCAD?

Click on the arrow by the axis button. Then unselect the check boxes for the axis you don't want visible.

How do you check XYZ in AutoCAD?

1. Click Home tab Utilities panel ID Point. Find.
2. Click the location that you want to identify. The X,Y,Z coordinate values are displayed at the Command prompt.

How do I use UCS command in AutoCAD?

To define your UCS manually, just click two points to define the orientation of the X axis. To set your UCS based on the the angle of an object in your drawing, such as a polyline, click that object. As you move the cursor up or down, youâ€™ll see a line extending 90 degrees from the object you selected.

How do I make an elevation plan?

What is flatten command in AutoCAD?

FLATTEN: This is a very useful command to know if you have trouble with lines that for some reason are not on 0 height. Select everything that you wanna have for sure on 0 elevation, type FLATTEN and everything will come to 0 elevation.
