In the left panel, click the workspace that is being transferred. Drag it from the left side of the workspaces tree, to the right side of the workspaces tree. Repeat step 3 for any other workspaces that are to be transferred. Save the resulting CUI file by clicking the floppy disk icon.

Also, how do I **export** custom **settings** in AutoCAD? 2) Make a zip file of your custom settings: Locate the folder for your latest working version and release of **AutoCAD**, look for a button in there called "export AutoCAD (version/release year) settings" and click it. Follow the prompts to save the zip file to a location of your choice.

You asked, how do I save my profile and **workspace** in AutoCAD?

1. In **AutoCAD**, on the ribbon, click View tab > Palettes panel > Tool Palettes.
2. Reposition the Tool Palettes window on-screen based on your preference of location.
3. In AutoCAD, on the status bar, click Workspace Switching.

4. On the menu, choose Save Current As.

Also know, where are **AutoCAD** workspaces stored?

1. Select the Transfer tab in the Customize User Interface dialog box.
2. You should now see your **workspace** listed under Workspaces in the right pane.
3. Select the Transfer tab in the Customize User Interface dialog box.

Considering this, what is a CUIx file? This file stores the **settings** youâ€™ve configured in your AutoCAD customized user interface (CUI). For example, you may have placed your ribbons and toolbars in your preferred locations, where they will be whenever you open AutoCAD.

How do I import a classic workspace in AutoCAD?

1. From the Manage tab in the ribbon, click Import.
2. In the customization editor, click the Transfer tab.
3. In the left pane, load the configuration file, acad.
4. From the workspace list in the left pane, drag AutoCAD Classic to the workspace list in the right pane.

What is an ARG file in AutoCAD?

Settings file used by AutoCAD, a 2D and 3D CAD drafting application; contains backed up user profile information (application options data) that was stored in the system registry; can be exported and imported to transfer settings between computers; can also be migrated between versions of AutoCAD.

Where are AutoCAD preferences?

To set these preferences, use the AutoCAD layerstate command instead. To set drawing preferences: Select Setup/Preferences from the Ribbon toolbar. The Preferences dialog appears.

Where are AutoCAD settings?

Click Application button > Options. In the Options dialog box, click a tab and set options as desired. Save the settings: To save the settings and keep working in the dialog box, click Apply.

How do I save my workspace in AutoCAD 2018?

1. On the status bar, click Workspace Switching, select Save Current As.
2. In the Save Workspace dialog box, enter a name for the new workspace or select a name from the drop-down list.
3. Click Save.

How do I copy a profile in AutoCAD?

1. Enter options on the command line.
2. In the Options dialog box, click the Profiles tab.
3. Select the current profile and click Export.
4. Select the file location and enter a name for the ARG file, and then click Save.

What formats can AutoCAD export?

DWG (drawing) format is supported by AutoCAD and other CAD applications. DXF (data transfer) is an open format that is supported by many CAD applications. A DXF file is a text file that describes a 2D drawing.

How do I save my workspace in AutoCAD 2020?

1. On the status bar, click Workspace Switching, select Save Current As.
2. In the Save Workspace dialog box, enter a name for the new workspace or select a name from the drop-down list.
3. Click Save.

What is the default workspace in AutoCAD?

Workspaces are often overlooked in AutoCAD LT. There's only one by default, which is Drafting & Annotation.

How do I add a CUIx file in AutoCAD?

C:\Documents and Settings\Local Settings\Application Data\Autodesk\AutoCAD 20xx.

How do I edit a CUIx file?

cui file is an XML file format, which can be edited using any ASCII or Unicode text editor. However, it is best to edit .cui files using an XML editor such as Visual Studio or Notepad++. If you are developing with progeCAD, you already have Visual Studio.

What are the 3 workspace types in AutoCAD?

1. 2D Drafting ribbon workspace – customized for those who are familiar with the AutoCAD ribbon and work primarily with drawing data.
2. Planning And Analysis ribbon workspace – customized for AutoCAD Map 3D toolset commands.

How do I copy a CUI file in AutoCAD?

What is AutoCAD workspace?

In AutoCAD Architecture 2021 toolset, a workspace is the basic user interface that includes those controls, commands, and palettes you need for your architectural process. When you first start AutoCAD Architecture 2021 toolset, the default Architecture workspace is displayed.
