1. In the Design workspace, on the Mesh tab, select Modify > Direct Edit .
2. In the canvas, select a mesh body.
3. In the dialog, click OK to enter the Direct Mesh Editing contextual environment.
4. On the Direct Mesh Editing tab, select Modify > Erase And **Fill** .

Furthermore, how do you use the patch tool in Fusion 360? In Fusion 360 look at the top ribbon bar. Select Model and choose the PATCH workspace to swap out. You can then look for the orange CREATE icon in the ribbon bar and choose "patch" and then you'll get a tabbed palette that will let you select the hole and patch it.

## How do you convert Mesh to solid?

To convert a mesh into a solid, on the Mesh ribbon, in the Convert Mesh panel, click the Convert To Solid tool. In the command window, you can see the type of conversion that will be applied. In this case, the solid will be smoothed and optimized.

## What is Patch in Fusion 360?

Patch is used to create a boundary patch surface, which is extremely useful for closing open faces in your model. The biggest advantage is that you can select a series of existing edges and Fusion will determine the patch to create. Select the Patch tool and the Patch dialog opens.

## How do you make a solid in Fusion 360?

1. In the Tool Ribbon along the top of Fusion 360 workspace, select the Surface tab.
2. From the modify dropdown select Stitch.
3. Select all the surfaces to stitch together.
4. On the stitch dialog set the operation to New Body.

## Where is the Patch environment in Fusion 360?

In the new User Interface, the Surface tab has replaced the Patch workspace as shown in the below image. The Surface tab can be found in the Design workspace.

## What is meant by surface Patch?

[ $\text{surface patch}$ ] (mathematics) A surface or a portion of a surface that is bounded by a closed curve.

## Where is the model tab in Fusion 360?

The Model workspace has been renamed the Design workspace. Sculpt, Surface, and Sheet Metal are available the tabs shown on the toolbar at the top of the screen.

## How do you simplify mesh in Fusion 360?

1. In the Design workspace, on the Mesh tab, select Modify > Reduce .
2. In the canvas, select a mesh body or face groups on a mesh body.
3. In the dialog, select a reduction Type and adjust associated settings:
4. Click OK.

## How do you edit a mesh in Fusion 360?

The tools in the Design > Mesh > Modify panel let you modify mesh bodies in Fusion 360.

## How do you convert to solid?

1. Click Home tab Solid Editing panel Thicken. Find.
2. Select the surfaces you want to thicken. Press Enter.
3. Specify a thickness for the solid. Press Enter.
