## Introduction

Select the Section Plane tool ( ) or select Tools > Section Plane. Microsoft Windows users **find** the **Section** Plane tool on the Sections toolbar. On both Microsoft Windows and Mac OS X, the Section Plane tool is on the Large Tool Set palette.

Additionally, where is section cut in SketchUp?

1. Open **SketchUp** and open your drawing.
2. Click the "Section Plane" tool from the Guide toolbar or the "Tools" menu.
3. Click on a section to **cut** into it. Press "Esc" to undo the cut.

Also, how do I toggle between **section** cuts in SketchUp? Open the Outliner window. Click on the current section plane and deactivate it, then select the other **section** plane and activate it. You can also move the camera, select the section plane in model, activate it and then untick and re-tick Active section plane in the Scenes panel.

Amazingly, how do I cut a **section** in SketchUp 2019?

Correspondingly, how do I add a **section** scene in **SketchUp**?

1. Select Window > Scenes to open the Scenes window.
2. Select the Add Scene icon ( ). The scene appears in the Scenes window with the default name of Scene 1.
3. If you want to change the name of your scene or add a description, select the Show Details icon ( ) in the upper right of the Scenes window.

1. Select the Trim tool ( ). Tip: Until you hover over a solid group or component, you see an arrow cursor with a circle and a slash.
2. Click to select the cutting group or component.
3. Click the group or component that you want to **cut**.

## What is a cut section?

A cut section, sometimes referred to as a "cutting plane", is a flat plane that cuts through the model. A cut section may be located anywhere in space and oriented at any angle.

As long as section cuts are placed inside separate Groups or Components, then you can add as many as you like.

1. Select where you want a new section to begin.
2. Go to Layout > Breaks, and then choose the type of section break you want. Next Page Starts the new section on the following page. Continuous Starts the new section on the same page.

## What is a sectional view?

A sectional view represents the part of an object remaining after a portion is assumed to have been cut and removed. The exposed cut surface is then indicated by section lines. Hidden features behind the cutting plane are omitted, unless required for dimensioning or for definition of the part.

## Why is my section cut black in SketchUp?

The black area you see is a section fill, because sketchup assumes your house is solid. select its roof and make it a component (default shortcut G key) so it becomes seperated, and youâ€™™ see the inside.

## How do you delete a section plane in SketchUp?

Select them in Outliner and press the Delete key.

## How do I select plane in Sketchup?

The angle the rectangle goes to naturally is determined by the angle of view. The more downward they are looking, the more likely the rectangle will be on the red/green plane. They can lock the direction, though, by hitting a cursor key. Up for blue, left for green, and right for red.

## What is removed section?

A section removed from its normal projected position in the standard arrangement of views is called a "removed" section. Such sections are labeled SECTION A-A, SECTION B-B, etc., corresponding to the letter designation at the ends of the cutting plane line.

## What does Section AA mean?

The cutting plane line is defined as A-A, and the section view is defined as view A-A. Figure 4-42. All surfaces directly visible must be shown in a section view. In Figure 4-43 the back portion of the object is not affected by the section view and is directly visible from the cutting plane.
