Introduction

One of the easier ways to do that is to open one of the plant faces for editing, triple click to select face and edges, then Shift+click on the face only to deselect it, then while the mouse is over an edge, R-click and choose Hide the selected edges. Repeat for each face in each plant.

Correspondingly, how do I make lines disappear in SketchUp?

1. Select the geometry you want to hide.
2. Context-click the selection and choose Hide from the context menu that appears, as shown in the figure. Or choose Edit > Hide. The selected geometry disappears from view, although it is still there, like a ghost in the machine.

Similarly, why is my **SketchUp** showing lines? Looks like you hit K to turn on back edges. Hit K again to turn them off. By the way, you might consider erasing guides once theyâ€™ve done their job.

In this regard, how do I remove a mesh line in SketchUp? To remove the mesh lines from objects in **SketchUp**, go to the **Default Tray** > **Style** > **Edit** and then uncheck **Edges** and **Profiles**.

Furthermore, how do I turn off hidden **lines**?

1. Click View tab Graphics panel Show Hidden drop-down (Show Hidden **Lines**).
2. Place the cursor on an element that is hiding another element, and click to select it.
3. Place the cursor on the element with lines to be shown, and click to select it.

1. Context-click an open area on an axis and select Hide from the menu that appears.
2. Select View > Axes from the menu bar. When a check mark appears next to the Axes menu item, selecting this option clears the Axes menu item and the axes are hidden from view.

How do you hide 3d lines in SketchUp?

How do you hide the lines of intersection in SketchUp?

Double-click to edit, click on empty space to quit editing. You can edit the groups forming your house and then select and hide (right-click > Hide) the edges you don't want to see.

How do you fix a broken line in SketchUp?

Draw an edge starting at the in-line point you want to remove and going a short distance in any direction. Then erase the new edge. The endpoint will go away with the edge. You can join many segments into a single polyline entity with the Weld plugin.

How do I clean up my SketchUp model?

Ensure all Layers are ON in the Layers-Browser. Delete anything you don't want in the Model "unlocking them as required"! In the Components-Browser use the pop-out menu to Purge Unused. In the Materials-Browser use the pop-out menu to Purge Unused.

What are object lines?

A visible line, or object line is a thick continuous line, used to outline the visible edges or contours of an object.

How do I delete hidden lines in Solidworks?

Displaying the Model With Hidden Lines Removed To display the model with hidden lines removed, do one of the following: Click Display Style > Hidden Lines Removed (Heads-up View toolbar). Click Hidden Lines Removed (View toolbar). Click View > Display > Hidden Lines Removed.

How do you hide hidden lines in Solidworks?

Right-click a feature or component in the drawing view or in the FeatureManager design tree and select Show/Hide, Show Hidden Edges. If the hidden edges are visible, you can hide them again by right-clicking the feature or component and selecting Show/Hide, Hide Hidden Edges.

How do I remove a line color in SketchUp?

1. open your model.
2. choose the window menu option.
3. choose the styles menu.
4. choose edit.
5. change the "color"™ drop down (at the bottom of the popup) from "by axis"™ to "all same"™.

How do you make ground white in SketchUp?

How do I remove background in layout?

How do I get rid of the grey background in layout? If you mean the model background colour, you can turn it on and off. Under the SketchUp model tab, goto styles and you will see a check box for background.

How do I turn off wireframe in SketchUp?

pull down the View Menu. Select the Toolbars menu item. Check the Styles toolbar option. Put the standalone Styles menu where you want it.

How do I get rid of dotted lines in SketchUp for free?

Hit k on your keyboard.

How do you change lines in SketchUp?

1. Click the Shape Style panel to open it.
2. Select the entity whose stroke you want to modify.
3. Click the Stroke option to select it.
4. Select your desired stroke settings, which are explained in detail in the upcoming list.

Where is purge in SketchUp?

Head to the Window option and click Model. Go to Info and click on Statistics. You should see the Purge Unused option here. Click it to tell SketchUp to get rid of any files you don't use.

How do you use clean up?

How do you skimp in SketchUp?

What are phantom lines?

Lines that are made visible as dots or dashes to reveal the edges of objects currently hidden from view.

What are hidden lines in drawing?

Hidden lines in a drawing represent the edges where surfaces meet but are not directly visible. Hidden lines are omitted from pictorial drawings unless they are needed to make the drawing clear. Figure 3.46 shows a case in which hidden lines are needed because a projecting part cannot be clearly shown without them.

What is invisible line?

“Invisible” lines (or implied lines or imaginary lines) trace paths of motion across the visual field. Invisible lines are very powerful, yet may not affect everyone exactly the same way. Consider, for example, the symbolic or associative feelings/nuances of: Horizontal lines. still, asleep, inert, silent.

How do I get rid of the GREY lines in Solidworks?

1. Click Display Style > Hidden Lines Removed (Heads-up View toolbar).
2. Click Hidden Lines Removed (View toolbar).
3. Click View > Display > Hidden Lines Removed.
