To open the command-line in Fusion 360, select Show Text Commands from the View dropdown menu. You can also use the keyboard shortcut Option + CMD + C on Mac OS or ALT + CTRL + C on

Windows OS. Opening the command line in Fusion 360 will make the Text Commands pane appear at the bottom.

How do I put text in a circle in Fusion 360?

Select the Text tool under the Create Menu. Click on the circle to select it and then choose Text on Path from the text dialog box. You should now see this dialog box. Type your text inside the Text field in the dialog box.

1. Change the Default units for new design to the desired unit. (metric or imperial)
2. Click Apply.
3. Click Ok.

How do you show units in Fusion 360?

What are the commands in Fusion 360?

1. Animate Workspace Commands. U.
2. CAM Workspace Commands. Ctrl + D | Command +D.
3. Canvas Selection. Ctrl + C | Command + C.
4. Drawing Workspace Commands. B.
5. Edit Form Commands. Alt + Drag.
6. Render Workspace Commands. A.
7. Sculpt Workspace Selection. Shift + Up Arrow.
8. Simulate Workspace Selection.

How do you explode text in fusion?

To explode the text, simply right click on the text and select "Explode Text." When you explode the text, it automatically creates sketch geometry based on your characters and the chosen font. Essentially, the explode option just outlines your characters with a combination of available sketch geometry.

How do you inlay text in Fusion 360?

Which is better Fusion 360 or Solidworks?

Fusion 360 is cloud-based and works on both Windows and Mac while SOLIDWORKS is purely Windows-based with cloud storage options. Fusion 360 has basic analysis and simulation tools, while SOLIDWORKS's analysis and simulation features are much more comprehensive. Fusion 360 has decent sculpt tools while SOLIDWORKS doesn't.

How do you make a dimension drawing in Fusion 360?

How do you dimension in Fusion 360?

First, simply click on the sketch geometry that you would like to dimension. Then, click on the bottom line. Then, as I drag my mouse cursor away from the line, you'll notice the sketch dimension appears. To place the dimension you'll need to click with your mouse, which then immediately opens the dimension input field.
