- 2. Right-click SteeringWheels, and click Save View.
- 3. Enter a name for the new 3D view, and click OK.

- 1. Start a new family from the Generic Model Pattern Based family template.
- 2. Select the tile pattern grid in the drawing area.
- 3. In the Type Selector, select the pattern grid closest to the shape and layout of your design.
- 4. You can now modify the tile geometry.

What is a hatch pattern?

A hatch pattern is consists of different combinations of horizontal, vertical or diagonal lines and are considered vector patterns.

How do you create a pattern file?

- 1. Open a text editor, such as Notepad, to begin creating the pattern file.
- 2. On the first line, enter the header in this format: *Concrete Paver.

- 3. On the next line, enter the type declaration: ;%TYPE=MODEL.
- 4. Create the first pattern descriptor, using the following values:

Use the Patterns tab of the Modify DWG/DXF Export Setup dialog to map Revit fill patterns to specific hatch patterns in DWG. Click File tab Export Options (Export Setups DWG/DXF).

STRAIGHT LAY PATTERN This is the most commonly used tile pattern of all, and the easiest to do. The tiles are simply laid side by side in a straight line, to give an overall even grid pattern. It's a good choice of pattern for rooms where you don't want the tiles to distract from other design features.

What is a tiling pattern?

Tiling patterns (or just patterns) are fill styles that fill a region (inside of the shape, outline, or transparency mask) by tiling a group of objects over the area. The pattern attributes determine the mode of tiling (geometry), spacing and direction of the pattern.

Can you make your own tile design?

Designing your own tiles allows you to create a theme or a focal point that expresses personality. A countertop or tiled wall takes on a new theme by designing rows of tiles or random tiles. In some cases, you may have a favorite flower pattern or astrological symbol that can be used as designs for tiles.
