2. In model space the Scale Area dialog box appears, in **layout** the View dialog box appears: Under border, click **Move**. choose ok.>
3. Select the target position for the viewport (2).
4. Choose OK.

1. **Move** the screen pointer over the viewport's title bar.
  2. Click and hold down the mouse's left button.
  3. Drag the viewport to the new location.
  4. Release the mouse button.

1. Enter **OPTIONS** in the **AutoCAD** command line.
  2. Select the **Display** tab in the Options dialog box.
  3. Under **Layout Elements**, select the **Display Layout and Model Tabs** check box.
  4. Click **OK**.
  5. The **MODEL/PAPER** toggle button will be displayed on the Status bar.

## How do I move a model in SketchUp layout?

1. In SketchUp, click the **Send to Layout** button. The LayOut application opens.
2. Select a LayOut template for your document. Your model opens in LayOut as a Sketchup viewport.

## How do I move in AutoCAD without a mouse?

Entering the **Zoom** command with the keyboard can be useful if you are working on a laptop without a mouse because you can simply press **Z Enter E Enter** for **Zoom Extents** or **Z Enter A Enter** for **Zoom All**.

## What is Move command in AutoCAD?

The **move** command in AutoCAD is used to move objects at a specified distance and direction. To move the objects with precision, we can use object snaps, grid snaps, coordinates, etc. There are four steps to move any object at a specific distance in a specified direction. Select objects. We need to select the objects.

## How do you move left and right in AutoCAD?

Selecting the **Pan** tool changes the cursor to a little hand icon that you click and drag in the drawing window to shift your display. If necessary, you can click and drag repeatedly until you reach the desired location in the drawing.

## How do you scroll in AutoCAD?

1. At the command prompt, enter **OPTIONS** and select enter.
2. On the **Display** tab, select **Display Scroll Bars** in **Drawing Window**.

## How do I resize a viewport?

1. Press Shift while dragging to maintain the original aspect ratio.
2. If you don't see the handles, toggle them by selecting View > Responsive > Viewport resize handles in the top menu.

## How do you move the camera in a viewport?

1. Zoom: Simply scroll the mouse wheel up or down while the cursor is over the viewport.
2. Orbit: Hold down the middle mouse button while moving your cursor around the viewport.
3. Pan: Hold down Shift and the middle mouse button while moving your mouse across the viewport.

## How do I change the viewport size in AutoCAD?

1. Click the Model tab.
2. Click a viewport to make it current.
3. Choose View > Zoom > Zoom.
4. Type the zoom scale factor relative to paper space by appending the suffix xp to the scale factor, and then press Enter.

## How do I change the LayOut of a scene?

In LayOut, right-click on a model viewport and choose Open with SketchUp from the context menu. In SketchUp, use the navigation tools to frame the view you want. Add a new scene to your model (View > Animation > Add Scene). Save your model.

## How do you relink in LayOut?

Relink to a moved or renamed file: If you move a file to a new location or rename the file, you need to let LayOut know where to find the file and the new filename. Select the outdated reference and click the Relink button to keep LayOut up to date.
