If you have a component/group with an unexpected big bounding box edit it and select all. now deselect everything you want to keep [hold down Shift+Ctrl whilst making a fenced selection] â€ Entity Info should report whatâ€™s still selected if anything -hit Delete.

1. With the Select tool (), select the geometry you want to scale.
2. Select the Scale tool () or press the S key.
3. Click an edge or face grip (not a corner grip).
4. Move the cursor to scale the entity.
5. Click to set your selectionâ€™s new scale.

How do I cut a section in SketchUp model?

1. Open SketchUp and open your drawing.
2. Click the â€Section Planeâ€ tool from the Guide toolbar or the â€Toolsâ€ menu.
3. Click on a section to cut into it. Press â€Escâ€ to undo the cut.

What is sectional plane?

Definition of section plane 1 : a surface seen in section (as in cross section) 2 : a hypothetical plane cutting a section.

How do I resize a component?

1. To scale only one instance of a component, select the component.
2. To scale all instances of a component in your model, double click the component and then select an entity within that component.
3. To resize an object and distort some of its dimensions, use the Scale tool.

How do you scale a dynamic component in SketchUp?

1. Context-click on the component.
2. Select the Dynamic Components > Component Attributes menu item.
3. Click the + button next to the component's name.
4. Click on the add attribute button in the last row of the attributes list.
5. Click on the Scale tool attribute in the list.

What is SketchUp outliner?

In SketchUp, the Outliner enables you to view a model's objects (groups, components, and section planes) as a hierarchical tree. With the Outliner, you can: Navigate large models. Name objects and section planes.

What is a cut section?

A cut section, sometimes referred to as a “cutting plane”, is a flat plane that cuts through the model. A cut section may be located anywhere in space and oriented at any angle.

How do I cut a section of a plan?

What is a sectional view?

A sectional view represents the part of an object remaining after a portion is assumed to have been cut and removed. The exposed cut surface is then indicated by section lines. Hidden features behind the cutting plane are omitted, unless required for dimensioning or for definition of the part.

How do I select plane in Sketchup?

The angle the rectangle goes to naturally is determined by the angle of view. The more downward they are looking, the more likely the rectangle will be on the red/green plane. They can lock the direction, though, by hitting a cursor key. Up for blue, left for green, and right for red.

Can you have 2 active section planes in SketchUp?

As long as section cuts are places inside separate Groups or Components, then you can add as many as you like.

How do you create two active section cuts at once?

To use simultaneously active planes, the trick is to group your model with a section plane and create another one outside the group. Create the first section plane, and place it at the desired position. To avoid letting any part of the model out, double-click the first section plane to de-activate it.

How do you create a section?

1. Select where you want a new section to begin.
2. Go to Layout > Breaks, and then choose the type of section break you want. Next Page Starts the new section on the following page. Continuous Starts the new section on the same page.

How do you make a sectional view?

How do I get sectional top view?

When the cutting plane cuts the object lengthwise, full sectional front view is obtained. It is also called longitudinal section. It may be noted that the top view or the side remain unaffected, that means top view is drawn full not half.
