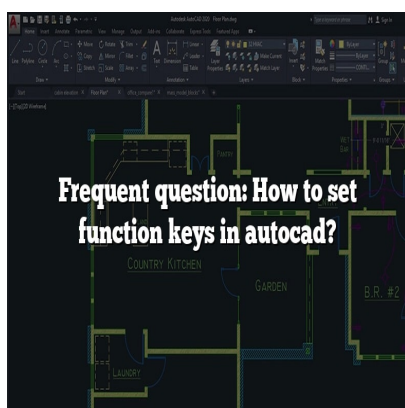

1. Select the Express Tools tab.
2. Select Command Aliases.
3. Click the Add button to create a new shortcut.
4. In the New Command Alias pop-up box, enter an Alias or shortcut and select an **AutoCAD** command from the drop-down list.
5. Click OK.
6. To overwrite the current default shortcut, click Yes.

Subsequently, how do I enable F keys in AutoCAD? Open Control Panel > Hardware and Sound > Windows Mobility Center (or search for Windows Mobility Center on the machine and open it directly). Under **Function** Key Row, change the setting from 'Multimedia keys' to 'Function **keys**'.

Likewise, how can you assign the keyboard characters or function keys to AutoCAD commands?

1. Run CUI.
2. On the left pane, expand ACAD > Keyboard Shortcuts > Shortcut Keys.
3. Click Toggle Ortho.
4. On the right pane, go to Properties > Access > Key(s).
5. Click
6. Enter F4 to assign it.

Moreover, how do I change the shortcut **keys** in **AutoCAD** 2019? In the Customize tab, Customizations In pane, select the Keyboard Shortcuts node. In the Shortcuts pane, filter the type and status for the keyboard shortcuts to print. In the Type drop-down list, select the type of keyboard shortcuts (All Keys, Accelerator **Keys**, or Temporary Override Keys) to display.

You asked, how do I **set** commands in AutoCAD?

1. In the Customize tab, Command List pane, click the Create a New Command button. A new command (named Command1) is displayed in both the Command List and Properties pane.
2. In the Properties pane, do the following: In the Name box, enter a name for the command.
3. Click Apply.

To enable FN Lock on the All in One Media Keyboard, press the FN key, and the Caps Lock key at the same time. To disable FN Lock, press the FN key, and the Caps Lock key at the same time again.

How do I change my function keys to Multimedia keys?

How do I enable f8 in AutoCAD?

1. From the START menu, open the Control Panel > Hardware and Sound > Windows Mobility Center (or search for Windows Mobility Center on the machine and open it directly).
2. Under Function Key Row, switch the setting from “Multimedia keys” to “Function keys”.

How do I change shortcuts in AutoCAD 2018?

1. Under the Manage tab on the ribbon, on the Customization panel, click the menu Edit Aliases > Edit Aliases.
2. The PGP file will open in Notepad.
3. Type in the desire command alias with the syntax:

5. On the command line in AutoCAD, type REINIT, select “PGP File” and then click OK.

function keys provide some shortcuts.

How do I change shortcuts in AutoCAD 2017?

In the Properties pane, click in the Key(s) box, and then click the [â€¦] button to open the Shortcut Keys dialog box. In the Shortcut Keys dialog box, hold down the modifier key Ctrl with a combination of Shift, Alt, or Shift and Alt along with the desired letter, number, function, or virtual key such as F1 or Insert.

How do I change shortcuts in AutoCAD 2015?

In the Customize tab, Customizations In pane, select the Keyboard Shortcuts node. In the Shortcuts pane, filter the type and status for the keyboard shortcuts to print. In the Type drop-down list, select the type of keyboard shortcuts (All Keys, Accelerator Keys, or Temporary Override Keys) to display.

How do I change shortcuts in AutoCAD 2022?

Click Tools menu > Customize > Interface (CUI). Select the Shortcuts tab. The default shortcut keys are displayed in the dialog box. Click to add a shortcut key to a command.

How do I show all commands in AutoCAD?

Press F2 to bring up the text window, This should show all commands since dwg has been opened.

How do I get to settings in AutoCAD?

Click Application button > Options. In the Options dialog box, click a tab and set options as desired. Save the settings: To save the settings and keep working in the dialog box, click Apply.

How do you add a new command?

1. Click the.
2. Select a context from the list.
3. Click the.
4. Enter the Spoken Phrase you want to use to trigger the command.
5. Optionally, enter a brief command Description.
6. Select the Context where you want to use the command.
7. Select the Type of command you want to create.

How do I set function keys without Fn?

Press the up-arrow or down-arrow keys to select the Action Keys Mode option, and then press the Enter key to display the menu. Select the Enabled option to require only the F1 through F12 keys to

use the action as indicated on the action key, without having to press the Fn key itself.

Why do my function keys not work?

If the function keys are not working, the problem may be you have a function lock or F-Lock key that needs to be toggled. The F-Lock key is used to turn on or off the F keys (F1 through F12) or secondary functions of the F keys. Some keyboards may label the F-Lock key as the Fn key.

Where is the F-Lock key?

On most keyboards, the "F-Lock" key is found above the 10-key number pad, directly above the "Num Lock" key. The key says "F-Lock" and sometimes has an "Fn" below it with a black square around it.

How do I make function keys default?

How do I change keyboard functions?

Connect the keyboard that you want to configure. Select the Start button, and then select Microsoft Mouse and Keyboard Center. From the displayed list of key names, select the key that you want to reassign. In the command list of the key that you want to reassign, select a command.
