Introduction

The research gives a mid-point for medium interactivity courses of approximately 180 hours development for every 1 hour of eLearning. Therefore, by their estimates, a 20 minute course would **take** 60 hours of development. If you work a 40 hour week, that’s about a solid week and a half of your hard labor.

Beside above, how long does it take to **create** an **eLearning** video? Recording: 1 to 2 months. Video Editing: it could **take** you several weeks depending on the editing needed.

People ask also, how many hours does it take to create an online course? Depending on the duration and detail of the program, it can take anywhere between 25 “ 500 hours to formulate an online course. A mini-course with just 4 or 5 videos you could develop it in a couple of days. An in-depth flagship course with numerous modules and assignments could take eight weeks or more to accomplish.

Additionally, how **long** does it take to build an eLearning module? It varies from module to module, but as a benchmark, some **eLearning** developers estimate it can take as much as 184 hours of

development for every **hour** of eLearning course. An **eLearning** module is typically 10-15 minutes **long**, so it would take roughly 46 hours for a 15-minute module according to this research.

Also, how long should eLearning **take**? Through countless hours of instructional design, field testing, and client feedback, I have found that 30 minutes is about the maximum, and less than 15 is too short. The exact number of minutes between 15 and 30 should be dictated by the depth and number of objectives in the learning module. In the study, 29% of respondents said it took them over 100 hours, while 87% **take** up to 16 weeks to develop their course. A good rule of thumb is to allow 2-3 months to account for research, designing the course, testing with students and finalizing.

How long should it take to develop a curriculum?

Doing it yourself means allocating key staff to do the curriculum design work and providing sufficient time for them to do it. It can take at least 10 days to create a long term curriculum plan and that's before you've nailed the detailed lesson sequencing, content and resources.

How long does it take to create a teachable course?

Creating an online course is a rewarding process, but not one that doesn't come with a bit of commitment. But if you go in with a plan, creating your online course doesn't have to be an overwhelming process and with a bit of planning you can easily create and launch your online course in just 60 days.

How long should eLearning modules be?

In summary, there is no prescriptive answer to how long an elearning course should be. 15 minutes, 30 minutes, 60 minutes or 90 minutes may all be completely fine.

How long should a virtual training session be?

Try not to schedule sessions that go longer than 1.5 hours. For a virtual session, ensure that you go through all the material to cover and only add pieces that would be best suited for a trainer-led virtual session. Don't ever go longer than 90 minutes without a break 75 is even better.

How long are online classes a day?

One of the many advantages of online schools is that they will require less time from you compared to traditional schools. But then again, it is highly dependent on the online school that you or your child is enrolled in. On average, students spend four hours online.

How many hours does it take to design a course?
