1. CREATE A NEW PHOTOSHOP DOCUMENT AT YOUR TARGET **TEXTURE** RESOLUTION.
2. RUN THE OFFSET COMMAND TO TEST FOR SEAMS.
3. USE THE SPOT HEALING BRUSH AND CLONE STAMP TO REMOVE THE SEAMS.
4. CHECK THE TEXTURE BY REPEATEDLY RUNNING THE OFFSET COMMAND.
5. CREATE TWO COPIES OF YOUR IMAGE.
