How to auto dimension in revit?

Description

- 1. Click on the Auto Dimensioning command.
- 2. Select the walls and grids that are to be taken into consideration in dimensioning. Press Enter.
- 3. Select the main wall along which the dimensions will be created and the position for the first dimension line.
- 4. As a result, a set of chain dimension lines is created.

- 1. In the drawing area, select the dimension you want to edit.
- 2. Double click on the dimension value.
- 3. In the **Dimension** Value field, select Use Actual Value.
- 4. Enter the text you want to display in the Above, Below, Prefix and/or Suffix text fields.
- 5. Click OK.

- Right-click and click Label, and then select an existing parameter or click. See Creating Family Parameters.
- 2. On the Label Dimension panel of the ribbon, for Label, select an existing parameter or click (Create Parameter).

- 1. Click Annotate tab Dimension panel (Linear).
- 2. Place the cursor at a reference point on an element, such as a wall or a line, or at the intersection of references, such as a join between 2 walls.
- 3. Click to specify the reference.

- 1. Click Annotate tab Detail panel Component drop-down (Repeating Detail).
- 2. Sketch the repeating detail, and then click Modify.
- 3. Click Modify | Detail Items tab Properties panel (Type Properties).
- 4. In the Type Properties dialog, click Duplicate, and enter a name for the repeating detail type.

Use the Tag tool to attach a tag to a selected element. A tag is an annotation for identifying elements in a drawing. A symbol is a graphic representation of an annotation element or other object. Tag multiple rebar and rebar sets with a single annotation.

How do you change dimension units in Revit?

- 1. Click Manage tab Settings panel.
- 2. In the Project Units dialog, select the discipline.
- 3. Select the value in the Format column to change the display value for that unit type.
- 4. Specify Units, if necessary.

Overall dimensioning should be placed outside of the smaller dimensions. When the overall is given, one of the smaller ones should be eliminated, unless it is needed for reference. In that case the dimension should be in parentheses. This dimension should be eliminated This dimension is needed.

How do you change rounding in Revit?

- 1. Click Manage tab Settings panel Project Units.
- 2. In the Project Units dialog, select a value from the Decimal symbol/digit grouping list.
- 3. In the Format column, click the button for the unit you want to use this setting.
- 4. Click OK twice.

How do you pin in Revit?

Revit displays a pushpin control near the element to indicate that it is pinned in place. To move or delete the element, you must first unlock it by clicking the pushpin control. Click the pushpin again to lock the element.

How do you repeat orders in Revit?

- 3. Press Enter to invoke the last-used command.
- 4. Assign a keyboard shortcut for Repeat Last Command.
