1. Launch AutoCAD and click the "Insert" tab.
2. Click "Attach" and select the PDF and the page you want to trace.
3. Enter the coordinates for the insertion and the scaling factor, where 1 is 100 percent.
4. Use the line, polyline, circle and arc tools to trace the shape as desired.
5. Click the "PDF Underlay" tab.

A trace is created in the AutoCAD web app or the AutoCAD mobile app to provide feedback, comments, markups, and design exploration of the drawing without altering the content of the drawing. You can also use the Trace palette to open and manage the traces available in the current drawing.

How do I import an image into AutoCAD without references?

Click Edit menu > Copy, or press CTRL+C. In AutoCAD, click Edit menu > Paste Special. Select the options Paste and Picture (Metafile) in the Paste Special box. Click OK.

How do I convert PDF to Zwcad?

1. execute command APPLOAD in ZWCAD.
2. select and load PDFConverter.zrx. (please note 32 bit and 64 bit version)
3. Now you have new command PDF2DWG or PDF2DXF, select the PDF file and follow the information in command line, then it will be converted.

How do I insert a JPEG into AutoCAD?

Using the ribbon by clicking on the Insert Tab, on the Reference panel, click on the Attach button. This will bring up the Select Reference File Dialog box. Make sure the File type is set to All image files in the Files of type field at the bottom. Then you can navigate to the image file you wish to attach.

How do I trace a PDF file?

Using Adobe Acrobat Pro, you can enable tracking just by clicking the SEND AND TRACK from the file tab. Once this is enabled, the author gets a message whenever the document is opened. Another method is to use apps like Digify to add tracking to your document.
