# How do you force quit in Cinema 4D?

The escape button actually has a use in Cinema 4d. If you hit playback on a stupid setup, to prevent yourself from having to force quit C4D, you can either keep hitting the play button an odd number of times, or keep pressing shift F to go to the start of your timeline, or despair, orâ€l press the Escape Button.

### How do I save a Cinema 4D file with textures?

To export an FBX, first select the File -> Export… -> FBX (\*. fbx) from Cinema 4D's menu bar. Select where you want to save your FBX then click Save .

Cinema 4D Lite can be accessed directly from within After Effects in the File ⇒ New menu, or by clicking Edit Footage on a Cinema 4D layer in your composition.

To enable interoperability, the Maxon CINEMA 4D rendering engine, is installed with Adobe After Effects. It can render CINEMA 4D files, and you can control some aspects of rendering, camera, and scene content on a per-layer basis.

- 2. MOGRAPH EFFECTORS ARE VERY LIMITED. MoGraph effectors are what put Cinema4D on the map.
- 3. RENDERING LIMITATIONS.
- 4. NO PLUG-IN SUPPORT.
