1. Open the Move command.
2. Select the Point to Point or Point to Position Move Type.

Frequent question, how do you use the midpoint in **Fusion** 360? When adding a dimensional or geometric constraint if you want to select the midpoint of a line or an arc then select the constraint press and hold the shift key then move your cursor close to the mid pint area of the geometry and the cursor will snap to the midpoint as shown in the animated gif below.

The answer: The Midpoint Shortcut. Hold down the "SHIFT" key on your keyboard and hover near the center of a line. You have hit the "Bullseye" when you notice a triangle with an X (shown below).

1. Animate Workspace Commands. U.
2. CAM Workspace Commands. Ctrl + D | Command +D.
3. Canvas Selection. Ctrl + C | Command + C.
4. Drawing Workspace Commands. B.
5. Edit Form Commands. Alt + Drag.
6. Render Workspace Commands. A.
7. Sculpt Workspace Selection. Shift + Up Arrow.
8. Simulate Workspace Selection.

1. Select the Equal constraint .
2. Select the circle that has the 50 mm dimension and the circle next to it.
3. Repeat by selecting the second circle and the circle next to it.
4. Repeat by selecting the third circle (located at the bend in the elbow) and the circle next to it.

What does over constrain the sketch mean?

The degrees of freedom affected by the current action are fully defined in the sketch with constraints and/or dimensions. By adding another dimension or constraint, violates or contradicts existing constraints or dimensions. This produces the overconstrained condition in the sketch.
