- 1. Click Options (Standard toolbar) or Tools > Options.
- 2. On the System Options tab, click Colors.
- 3. Under Color scheme settings, select one of the following:
- 4. Click Edit, select a color from the palette, then click OK.
- 5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 to **change** colors for other selections.

Considering this, how do I recolor furniture in SketchUp? Enter edit mode in the component by context clicking on the **component**. Scroll to "Edit Componentâ€. Click on the face of the element you want to change color. Use the Paint Bucket tool to apply the new color or sample a color from an element already in your model.

How do I change the color of a component in Solidworks?

Click Options (Standard toolbar) or Tools > Options. On the Document Properties tab, click Model Display. Under Model / feature colors, select Shading. Click Edit and select a color from the Color palette or click Define Custom Colors and define a color of a new shade or hue.

How do I paint a component in SketchUp?

To paint a whole group or component, select it and apply a material. When you select a group or component and apply a material, only faces in the default material are painted. To paint geometry within the group or component, double-click it to open its context. Then select the faces you want to paint with a material.

Scroll down to Drawings > Paper Color and select it. Click edit to open the dialog box that lets you select the color. You can choose predefined colors, or create your own from the color plot and by entering the RGB information.

Editing all instances of a component To open the context, you can double-click the component. Or select it, context-click the selection, and choose Edit Component, or simply hit Enter. Use the SketchUp drawing tools to edit your component.
