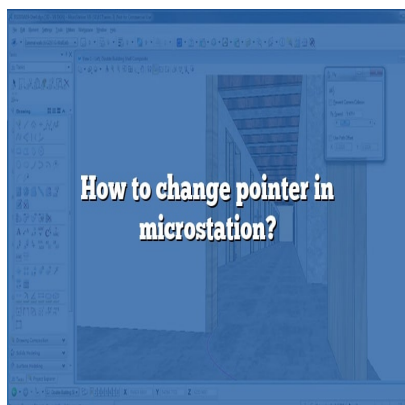




How to change pointer in microstation?

Description

Engineers in the fields of technical drawing use Microstation software to create a coherent design. All engineers must be able to meet changing design requirements with the suite of tools.

Introduction

You can do this by going to the File > Settings > User > Preferences > Input. Once there you can **change** the **Pointer** Size to Full View which will give you the crosshairs covering the screen.

Similarly, how do I change the cursor color in **MicroStation**? Go to Settings > File > Design File Settings > Color, Change 'Drawing Pointer Color' as shown in the below snapshot.

Moreover, how do I change the crosshair color in MicroStation v8i? You can **change** it using MicroStation key-in. Open it from menu utilities> key-in. Now type (or choose from fields) set xor. Then choose which color you want in the 3rd column.

Also, what is display set in **MicroStation**?

Best answer for this question, how do I turn on reference display in MicroStation?

1. From the References dialog box select the Reference File in the dialog you want to work with.
2. From the Reference dialog box pull down menu Settings > Presentation.
3. Check ON Use View Flags.

4. Toggle ON or OFF the View Attributes you want for the reference file.

What is a smart line in MicroStation?

Place SmartLine is a tool that produces different type of elements depending on used setting. As Daniel Clark wrote, using Join elements checkbox you can define whether a line will be placed as one line string or as a series of independent lines.

How do you match line styles in MicroStation?

1. Go to the Change Attribute tool.
2. Click on eyedropper(Match Element Attributes)
3. Select the attributes you want to match by checking appropriate boxes.
4. Select new element to apply the attributes from first element.

How do I set display depth in Microstation?

Option 1: The display depth can be set via keyin DD= or DP= and the value of the front and back clipping planes. Option 2: The display depth can also be set using the Set display depth tool in the 3D view control tool box.

How do I hide the element in my Bentley View?

Simply right click on an element and select Hide in View. That element is then hidden.

How do I set active depth in Microstation?

1. Make sure at least two views are open.
2. Select the Set Active Depth view control.
3. Select the view in which to set the Active Depth.
4. Enter a data point in a different view at the desired Active Depth for the view selected in step 3.

Where is level display in MicroStation?

How do you show level overrides in MicroStation?

From the View Attributes dialog, check the Level Symbology box to display the Overrides. Uncheck this box to return to ByLevel Symbology. panel, check the Level Overrides box to print the Override Symbology.

How do you change level attributes in MicroStation?

1. Select the elements required to be changed.
2. Choose the "Change Element Attributes"™ tool from the Ribbon (or popup menu)
3. In the Tool Settings dialog, place a checkmark(s) against the attribute to change and select the required Attribute.

How do you create a tag in MicroStation?

To create a tag set in MicroStation, go to the Element pull-down menu, select Tags / Define and the Tag Set dialog box opens. The Tag Set dialog box. Click Add under the Sets window in this dialog box. The Tag Set Name dialog box opens.

Where is level manager in MicroStation?

MicroStation Level Manager To open level manager, you can access MicroStation menu: Settings>Levels>Manager. You can create a level, rename it, and change its attributes. You can also see whether the levels are used in your drawing or not. You can only delete level that is not in used.

How do you cut elements in MicroStation?

Trim Elements. Select a line to be the "cutter." Then select a line, circle or arc it intersects. Click on the side of the cutter you want eliminated.

How do I change the length of a line in MicroStation?

1. Edit placed text node.
2. Go the textstyle dialog by selecting the text styles button on the Edit Text tool settings.
3. Go to the spacing section under the Advance tab.
4. Change the value of the line length.
5. Modify text and accept changes by clicking left mouse button.

How do you delete in MicroStation?

In the MicroStation environment, you can delete elements by clicking on them using the Delete Element tool, or by highlighting the element to be deleted and clicking your keyboard's Delete key.

What is display depth?

The depth of the screen is the exponent of the power of 2 expressing the number of colors displayed on your monitor. For example, if your monitor is set for 256 colors (2^8), the depth of your screen is 8. The following predefined constants are provided by 4D: Constant.
