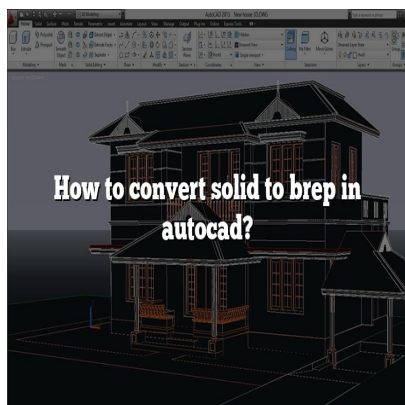

Switch off the history of edits on your 3D **solid** using the SOLIDHIST variable, with the **BREP** command, or with the “History” option in the Properties window (Ctrl+1).

Quick Answer, how do you **convert** solids in **AutoCAD**?

1. Click Home tab **Solid** Editing panel Thicken. Find.
2. Select the surfaces you want to thicken. Press Enter.
3. Specify a thickness for the solid. Press Enter.

Also, how do you **convert** a 3D solid to a polyline in **AutoCAD**?

Beside above, how do you convert 3D solid to mesh?

1. Click Mesh tab Convert Mesh panel Convert Options drop-down.
2. Specify one of the following conversion options: Smooth, optimized.
3. Click Mesh Modeling tab Convert Mesh panel **Convert to Solid**.
4. Select a mesh object that has no gaps or intersecting faces.

In this regard, how do you make a solid object 3D in AutoCAD?

1. If necessary, on the status bar click Workspace Switching and select 3D Modeling. Find.
2. Click Solid tab > **Solid** panel > Extrude. Find.
3. Select the objects or edge subobjects to extrude.
4. Specify the height.

1. To convert polyface mesh to solid download & install Automesher converter.
2. Restart AutoCAD program to force the initial application configuration.
3. Type AMCONVERTMESH command in the command line window.
4. Select your input polyface mesh to convert into solid from AutoCAD drawing.

How do you make a 3D polyline a 2D polyline in AutoCAD?

1. Click Modify tab Design panel Convert 3D To 2D Polylines Find.
2. Select the polyline(s) to convert. Press Enter.

How do you convert lines into polylines?

1. Type PEDIT and Press ENTER.
2. Type M and Press Enter.
3. Select objects and Press Enter.
4. Press Enter.
5. Type J and Press Enter.
6. Press Enter.
7. Press Esc (Escape)

How do I convert 3D AutoCAD to 2D?

Where is mesh to BRep?

Mesh to BRep is only available in Direct Modeling Mode. To enter direct modeling mode, right-click on the Fusion 360 Browser > select "Do Not Capture Design History." A warning dialog will appear.

How do you make a 3D model in AutoCAD?

1. Change the workspace. You have to change the workspace, and then you have to open a new file by using a 3D template.

2. Click the Application button and choose New. Once this is done click Drawing and the Select Template dialog box will appear.
3. Finally choose your units.

How do you extrude solids?

1. If necessary, on the status bar click Workspace Switching and select 3D Modeling. Find.
2. Click Solid tab > Solid panel > Extrude. Find.
3. Select the objects or edge subobjects to extrude.
4. Specify the height.

How do I change from 2-D to 3D in AutoCAD 2020?

Click the "cube" icon at the top right of the canvas and then drag the mouse until the top, right and front sides of the cube are visible. This changes the viewpoint from 2-D to 3-D, allowing you to see the three-dimensionality of the 3-D form that you'll create from the 2-D model.

SpaceClaim "repair and try stitch, merge face, free face and all other option to repair your geometry and you can see the left tree to conversion after repairing your model. Everything will be solid after the process of repair.

How do you convert a surface body to a solid Body Fusion 360?

1. In the Tool Ribbon along the top of Fusion 360 workspace, select the Surface tab.
2. From the modify dropdown select Stitch.
3. Select all the surfaces to stitch together.
4. On the stitch dialog set the operation to New Body.
