1. Right-click on the body in the browser then select Copy.
2. Activate the destination design.
3. Right-click on the top node in the browser and select Paste.

Similarly, how do you copy a body to Fusion 360? You can copy Components between designs, so if the body is in a component on it's own, select the component and Copy change to the other design right click on the canvas and select Paste New. If the body is in a component with other bodies you'll have to use Create components from bodies first.

In this regard, how do you copy and move in Fusion 360? The Move/Copy command moves or copies components, bodies, faces, or sketch objects in Fusion 360. You can select components, bodies, faces, or sketch objects and use the Move/Copy command to move them, rotate them, or copy them. Values are stored parametrically, and you can edit them later.

How do you copy a fusion sketch?

1. Select the sketch entities to be copied (either left-click or window select).
2. Right-click and select Copy.
3. Click to deselect the copied entities.
4. Edit Sketch or Create Sketch so that sketch mode is active.
5. Right-click and select Paste.

How do you merge sketches with Fusion?

How do I project a sketch to a surface in fusion?

How do you copy a image?

Select what you want to copy. Tap Copy. Touch & hold where you want to paste. Tap Paste.

How do you copy a drawing into another paper?

All you need is a soft graphite pencil or stick. Take the graphite and cover the back of the surface of the drawing that you want to transfer. This is called "carboning" the surface. Lay the drawing down on the surface that you to transfer the drawing to and then just trace the image.

How do you copy a picture and draw it?

How do you copy and paste into place in CAD?

Copy and Paste with Base Point Press Ctrl+Shift+C or enter COPYBASE at the command prompt. Select the base point. Select the objects to copy and press Enter. The objects are now available to be pasted into the same drawing or another drawing.

How do you copy and paste a shape in Autodesk Sketchbook?

Copying and pasting layers in Sketchbook Pro for desktop If you want to copy and paste content, use one of the selection tools and make your selection, then do the following: Use the hotkey Ctrl+C (Win) or Command+C (Mac) to copy the content. Use the hotkey Ctrl+V (Win) or Command+V (Mac) to paste.

How do I copy a base in CAD?

Select your Object and then Select CTRL+SHIFT+C. 2.) Select a Base Point to Copy from. 3.)

How do you modify a body in Fusion 360?

You need to use the concept of "direct modeling". Fusion 360 has some tools for that, as @TrippyLighting said above. In the MODIFY tab, there is a tool called "Press and Pull", which makes dimension editing, for example. But you have other tools, like Delete, Move/Copy, Split Face or Body.
