Introduction

Choose Edit > Copy from the menu bar or use a keyboard shortcut (Ctrl+C for Windows, Command+C for macOS) to copy your selection. Select Edit > Paste from the menu bar or use a keyboard shortcut (Ctrl+V for Windows, Command+V for macOS) changing the cursor to the Move tool icon.

Beside above, how do you copy and paste in SketchUp LayOut? Cutting, copying, and pasting elements in the drawing area Select Edit > Copy or press Ctrl+C (Microsoft Windows) or Command+C (Mac OS X) to copy the selected items to the clipboard without deleting the items from your LayOut document.

As many you asked, how do you copy distance in SketchUp? To make copies, activate the Move tool and press the Ctrl key (Option on the Mac). SketchUp is very flexible in how you can set the spacing and number of copies: After the first copy is made, you can enter the number of copies you want and set the spacing between them.

How do I select only a line in SketchUp?

Old post but looking for a solution in selecting only edges, I found this: • Left-Click, hold and select by the left corner up to the down right. • This will select only the edges in the selected window. Hope the answer is not too out of the subject. Yes, that works.

How do you repeat an action in SketchUp?

How do you copy multiple times?

Copy and paste multiple items using the Office Clipboard. Select the first item that you want to copy, and press CTRL+C. Continue copying items from the same or other files until you have collected all of the items that you want. The Office Clipboard can hold up to 24 items.

How do you copy an array in SketchUp?

External Array. Open up SketchUp and select the item that you wish to copy. Click on the Move icon and start to move it. After you start to move it, press down on CTRL and move it to where you want the copy.

How do you copy and paste and edit it?

1. Cut. Select Cut. or press Ctrl + X.
2. Paste. Select Paste. or press Ctrl + V. Note: Paste only uses your most recently copied or cut item.
3. Copy. Select Copy. or press Ctrl + C.

How do you copy and paste in sketchbook?

Copying and pasting layers in Sketchbook Pro for desktop. If you want to copy and paste content, use one of the selection tools and make your selection, then do the following: Use the hotkey Ctrl+C (Win) or Command+C (Mac) to copy the content. Use the hotkey Ctrl+V (Win) or Command+V (Mac) to paste.

How do you move an object to a specific distance in SketchUp?

1. Select the entities you want to move with the Select tool.
2. Activate the MoveM tool.
3. Click once to start the move.
4. Tap the Right Arrow key to define the direction.
5. Type in 2" ENTER to define the distance.

How do you offset an object in SketchUp?

1. Select the Offset tool () or press the F key.
2. Click one of your selected line segments or the face you want to offset.

3. Move the cursor to define the offset dimension.
4. Move the cursor to define the offset dimension.
5. Click to finish the offset.

How do you select and drag in SketchUp?

How do I select material from a model in SketchUp?

1. Select the Paint Bucket tool ().
2. In the Materials panel that opens, click the Select tab.
3. From the drop-down list, select a materials collection.
4. Click the material you want to use.
5. Back in the drawing area, click a face or faces to apply the material.

How do you select an object by material in SketchUp?

Go to your material browser > In model and right click on a material and choose "Select". It will then select all faces with the same material but only in the context you are in i.e. if the faces are within a group, and you have painted them within the group's context, they will not be selected.

What happens when you triple click a face in SketchUp?

You can assign a shortcut for when a face or edge is already selected. Select a face, then open the Preferences dialog to the Shortcuts panel. Choose "Edit/Item/Select/All Connected" in the Function list. Click in the "Add Shortcut" box and type the keychord you wish, then click the + button.

How do I selectively copy text?

Start by selecting the first block of text with the mouse. Then, scroll to the next block of highlighted text and hold down the Ctrl key while you select that. Once youâ€™ve selected all the blocks you want to copy, press Ctrl + C.

How do I copy and paste fast?

Put your cursor to the left of where you want the content you just copied. Press and hold down your â€œCtrlâ€• key on your keyboard and then press your â€œVâ€• key. This pastes the content in that spot.

How do I copy and paste?

1. Long-tap a word to select it on a web page.
2. Drag the set of bounding handles to highlight all the text you want to copy.
3. Tap Copy on the toolbar that appears.
4. Tap and hold on the field where you want to paste the text until a toolbar appears.
5. Tap Paste on the toolbar.
