Introduction

From the Resource Manager, click New Resource, select Hatch, and then click Create. Alternatively, from the Resource Manager, select Hatches from the list of resource types on the tool bar, and click New **Hatch**. The Edit **Hatch** dialog box opens.

People ask also, how do you add a hatch in **Vectorworks**? Select the object, and then select Hatch from the Attributes palette fill list. If no hatches are defined, and default content is not enabled in Vectorworks preferences, you are prompted to add a default hatch definition. To change to a different hatch, click the Fill Hatch selector.

Also, how do I change the **hatch** scale in Vectorworks?

Also the question is, how do you **create** a pattern in Vectorworks?

1. Select File > Document Settings > Patterns.
2. When all edits are complete, click OK to save the customized patterns. The edited patterns are available from the Fill Pattern and Pen Pattern boxes on the Attributes dialog box, for the current file only.

Additionally, how do you create a tile in **Vectorworks**?

1. From the Resource Manager, click New Resource, select Tile, and then click **Create**.
2. Click OK to open a tile editing window.
3. To adjust the tile pattern and spacing, click one of the repetitions and drag it; click again to set the new position.

Select object with **hatch** and the "Attribute Mapping Tool"™. Select a side of a hatch to move it over the surface. Select a midpoint to rotate the hatch over the surface.

How do I import a texture into Vectorworks?

Click the texture and drag it to the desired object, or select the desired object(s), and double-click the texture to apply. Alternatively, select the object, right-click (Windows) or Ctrl-click (Mac) on the texture, and select Apply from the context menu.

How do you add materials in Vectorworks?

Select the object, and then right-click on the resource, and select Apply from the context menu. Alternatively, double-click the resource, or drag the resource onto the object to apply it. To edit the mapping, use the Object Info palette or the Attribute Mapping tool. The texture is applied to the selected object(s).

How do you make a ceiling in Vectorworks?

How do you fill an object in Vectorworks?

From the Resource Selector, double-click a tile to apply it. If there are no tiles defined in the file and default content is not enabled, you are prompted to add a default tile definition. To customize the tile fill for the selected object, click the Fill Tile Settings button.

How do you create a texture in Vectorworks?

1. From the Resource Manager, click New Resource, select Renderworks Texture, and then click Create.
2. Click OK to create a texture with the name and properties specified in the Edit Texture dialog box.

How do you download textures in Vectorworks?

1. Select the command.
2. Click Settings.
3. Select the settings and click OK.
4. Use the mtextur filters and search function to locate the resources for download.
5. For the selected mtextur resource, click CAD- & BIM-TEXTUR to download.

To edit a simple material: From the Resource Manager, right-click on the material in the active file and select Edit from the context menu.

How do you make an object solid in Vectorworks?

How do you color a shape in Vectorworks?

1. Select Color By Class to use the color attributes set by the object's class.
2. If Use at Creation is enabled for the object's class, the object's color is automatically set by the class.

How do you fill a color in Vectorworks?

From the Attributes palette, click one of the color boxes for Fill color (either a Solid or Pattern fill style must be selected) or Pen color (any pen style can be selected). The Color Palette set opens, displaying

the colors in the active color palette.

How do you color walls in Vectorworks?

Where is the resource manager in Vectorworks?

Select Window > Palettes > Resource Manager to open the Resource Manager.
