How do I create a cell in MicroStation?

How do I create a macro in MicroStation?

1. Open any design file.
2. Go to Utilities|Macro|Create BASIC Macro
3. From the "Create Macro" dialog box, add a name in the "Name:" field and a description in the "Description:" field.

How do I make a cell library in MicroStation?

To create a cell library: 1. Select Element menu > Cells to open the Cell Library dialog. 2. Select Cell Library File menu > New item to display the Create Cell Library dialog.

How do I create a vertical profile in InRoads?

To Display a Vertical Alignment 1. Select Geometry > View Geometry > Active Vertical to display a graphic of the active vertical alignment. Note: Alternately in the you can right-click on the vertical alignment in the InRoads Explorer window and select View.

What is vertical alignment in road design?

The vertical alignment of highway generally defined as the presence of heights and depths in vertical axis with respect to horizontal axis of alignment. These heights and depths in roads may be in the form of gradients (straight lines in a vertical plane) or vertical curves.

How do I create an alignment in Openroads?

Use the Start Station tool to set the alignment's Starting Station. From the Task menu, select Civil Tools > Horizontal Geometry > Start Station. A Start Distance can be specified to set the Start Station anywhere along the alignment.

How do I view profiles in MicroStation?

How do I cut my profile in OpenRoads?

From Tool Settings and the Heads-Up Prompt, you will be prompted to select a placement method of either Full Profile or Corners. Full Profile creates a cut along the entire length of the profile, and Corners allows you to select an area with a box in the profile view to create the cut.

How do I set up a Bentley connect account?

Fill out the "Create your profile" dialog with your email address (look in Outlook) and name. Then click the green "Register Now" button to self register. An email with a verification code will be sent to your work email. Enter the Verification Code and click "Verify" to complete the account creation process.

What is connection client?

The CONNECTION Client guides users through the registration process and enables them to sign in. Once registered and signed in, users can run any of the products their Organization has an Entitlement (license) for as part of their contract.

How do I stop Bentley Connection client from popping up?

The Bentley CONNECTION Client is free. That's correct, there is no cost for the CONNECTION Client. Every employee who uses any Bentley software, must be registered (via your ODOT email address) with Bentley. To get the pop up to go away "log in and set the preferences to run minimized."

How do I create a group in Microstation?

Use the Element Selection tool to select the element(s) to be added to the named group. From the Utilities menu, choose Named Groups. The Named Groups dialog box opens. In the named groups list box, select a named group to which to add the elements.

What are cells in Microstation?

You can define which cell library you want to use from cell library dialog box. Access it from MicroStation menu element>cell.
