

How to create tags in sketchup?

Introduction

You can use tag visibility to not only set up scenes in SketchUp, but also to set up your model for efficient operation. To control visibility with tags, first create tags in the Tags panel. You can then assign tags to selected objects using the Tag tool or the Tag dropdown in Entity Info.

Amazingly, how do I add tags in SketchUp?

Correspondingly, how do you add tags in SketchUp 2021?

1. Open the tags panel.
2. Click on the plus-in-a-circle sign in the upper left corner.
3. A new blank tag appears.
4. Type in the name of the tag (Hint: see the tip above.)
5. Now you can add this tag to an entity.

People ask also, how do you make a nametag in SketchUp?

Similarly, are tags the same as layers in SketchUp? In SketchUp, Tags (old name "Layers") do NOT prevent geometry (edges, faces, section planes) from interacting with geometry assigned to other Tags (Layers).

What is SketchUp outliner?

In SketchUp, the Outliner enables you to view a model's objects (groups, components, and section planes) as a hierarchical tree. With the Outliner, you can: Navigate large models. Name objects and section planes.

Did SketchUp 2020 get rid of layers?

In an effort to increase model performance, you no longer have to create Layers upon Layers. You can do your main model organization straight within Outliner.

How do you lock an element in SketchUp?

Right click on the component you wish to lock and choose "lock" from the popup menu. The component bounding box will turn red if selected indicating it is locked. Right click and choose unlock to reverse.

Why can't I hide tags SketchUp?

You need to keep Layer0 set as the active layer and have your components on other layers, then use the visibility box for them. You cannot hide the layer that has the dot on the left. And that dot should always be on layer0.

How do I create a group in SketchUp?

1. With the Select tool (), select all the entities you want to include in your group.
2. Select Edit > Group from the menu bar. Or context-click the selection and choose Group from the menu that appears. Everything in the selection becomes grouped within a bounding box.

What is the difference between group and component in SketchUp?

By definition, a Group is a single instance of a collection of geometry. A Component is a named collection of geometry that can exist at multiple locations within the model. Each instance is a repetition of all others. A change to one instance changes all other instances.

How do you use the section plane in SketchUp?

1. Select the Section Plane tool () or select Tools > Section Plane. Microsoft Windows users find the Section Plane tool on the Sections toolbar.
2. With the section plane cursor, shown in the following figure, click a face to place your section plane.

How do I lock an image in SketchUp?

Select your image, right click on it and select lock. The image outline should turn red. To edit, or delete the image, right click again and select unlock.

Now, if you want to unhide them, then go to the Edit menu of the menu bar, which is at the top of the working screen, and click on it. Here in the scroll-down list of it, you will find Unhide option.

How do you hide and unhide objects in SketchUp?

1. Follow these steps to hide in SketchUp:
2. Step 1: Select the line or plane or object that you want to hide.
3. step 2: After that, right-click and select hide from all options that appear.
4. Step 3: OR if you want to use another method, click on the "Edit" on the menu bar and then click on the Hide.

How do you add objects to a group?

1. Click (regular left-click) the group of 3.
2. Hold the shift key down while clicking the 4th object. By holding shift down you're telling the computer you want all objects to be active (or selected).
3. Release the mouse, and on the keyboard press Ctrl+G.

How do you link shapes in SketchUp?

Select the Join tool (), which you find on the default toolbar or by selecting Tools > Join. Click an edge in each piece with the Join tool cursor. A blue outline flashes as you click, and the shape begins to inherit the fill color of the first shape that you click.

How do I create a dynamic component in SketchUp?

1. Select the component you want to make dynamic.
2. On the Dynamic Components toolbar, click the Component Attributes tool () or select Window > Component Attributes.
3. Click the Add Attribute plus sign icon to see a list of options.
