1. Select the Trim tool (). Tip: Until you hover over a solid group or component, you see an arrow cursor with a circle and a slash.
2. Click to select the cutting group or component.
3. Click the group or component that you want to cut.

Likewise, can you cut a section in SketchUp? SketchUp enables you to show section cuts in scene animations. To animate scenes that show different section cuts, you need to save the section settings in a style and then save each view in a scene.

Select the edges you want to drape over the TIN. Select the Drape tool () from the Sandbox toolbar or select Tools > Sandbox > Drape. Click the TIN to drape the selected edges onto the TIN, as shown on the right in the following figure (Callout 2).

To do this, select the Shape you want to edit, enable the tool via Layer > Path > Scissors (you can also add it to your toolbar via View > Customize Toolbar) and click on any of the paths that make up your shape to remove them.

Where is the split tool in SketchUp?

To split a line or shape, Select the Split tool (), which you find on the default toolbar or by selecting Tools > Split from the menu bar. Click on the line or shape edge where you want to split it.

How do you make a 45 degree cut in SketchUp?

Method 2: Make an Angled Cut in Sketchup with a Plane Use the rectangle tool to draw a plane that is perpendicular to the tube. Rotate. Press **R** to open the rotate tool and rotate the plane 45 degrees towards the tube.

1. Context-click a line or arc.
2. Select Divide from the context menu. SketchUp place points on the line or arc to show where it will be divided.
3. Move the cursor toward the center of the line or arc to reduce the number of segments.
4. Click the line when the number of segments you would like is shown.

How do you edit shapes?

1. Click the shape that you want to change. To select multiple shapes, press and hold CTRL while you click the shapes.
2. Under Drawing Tools, on the Format tab, in the Insert Shapes group, click Edit Shape .
3. Point to Change Shape, and then click the shape that you want.

How do you make slices in sketch?

To define a slice, use the slice tool (Insert > Slice or the shortcut **⌘S** key). Then drag and drop to draw the slice area. Creating a slice is as simple as selecting the slice tool and dragging the slice area. To transform an exportable element into a slice, just click the slice icon in the export interface.

How do I crop a circle in sketch?

In the upper righthand corner click the plus sign and insert an oval shape. Hold **⌘Shift** as you draw the shape to keep the proportions the same and create a circle. Center the circle after you have drawn it to your desired size.
