Introduction

1. On the Edit tab, in the Features group, click Modify .
2. Expand **Divide** and click Divide .
3. Click Active Select.
4. If you select more than one feature, do one of the following in the pane:
5. Confirm Show Preview is checked.

Furthermore, how do you split a multipart polygon in ArcGIS?

1. Click the Edit tool. on the Editor toolbar.
2. Select the multipart feature you want to separate into individual features.
3. Click Explode. on the Advanced Editing toolbar.

People ask also, how do you divide a line into equal parts in ArcGIS?

1. Click the Edit tool. on the Editor toolbar and click the feature.
2. Click the Editor menu and click Split.
3. Click the **Into Equal Parts** split option and type the number of parts.

4. Click OK.

In this regard, how do you split a polygon in GIS?

1. Click the Edit tool .
2. Click the **polygon** you want to split.
3. Click the Current Task drop-down arrow and click Cut **Polygon** Features.
4. Click the tool palette drop-down arrow and click the Sketch tool .
5. Construct a line sketch that cuts the original polygon as desired.
6. Right-click anywhere on the map and click Finish Sketch.

Subsequently, how do you split a polygon in **ArcGIS** pro?

1. On the Edit tab, set your snapping preferences and show the Modify Features pane.
2. In the pane, expand **Divide** and click Split .
3. Click Interactive.
4. To split any polygon feature you cross with a line segment, check Allow splitting without a selection.

To split a polygon, use the Cut Polygons tool, then draw a line across the **polygon**. The cut operation updates the shape of the existing feature and creates one or more new features. If there is no domain assigned to a field, the attribute values are copied from the original feature to the new feature.

How do you break a line in GIS?

1. At the location where you click (Editor toolbar > Split tool)
2. At a specific distance or percentage (Editor menu > Split command)
3. Into an equal number of parts (Editor menu > Split command)

How do I cut a polyline in Arcgis?

1. Start ArcMap.
2. Load data in the map if necessary.
3. On the main menu, click Customize > Toolbars > Production Editing.
4. Click the Production Start Editing button.
5. Select a polyline feature to split.
6. Click the Split tool.
7. Click the feature at the location where you want to split the polyline.

Where is the split polygon tool?

You can split multiple polygon faces on one mesh or across multiple meshes in one operation using the Multi-Cut Tool. Access the Multi-Cut Tool by: The Tools section of the Modeling Toolkit window, and clicking . The main menu bar, by selecting Mesh Tools > Multi-Cut.

How do I trim a polygon in Arcgis?

1. Click the Edit tool. on the Editor toolbar.
2. Select the feature you want to use to clip.
3. Click the Editor menu and click Clip.
4. Type a buffer value.
5. Click the type of clip operation: whether to discard or maintain the area that intersections.
6. Click OK to clip the feature.

How do I split a shapefile in Arcgis pro?

How do I split a layer in ArcGIS?

1. Once you have created polygons for each feature class, click the Intersect link in the right pane.
2. From the first drop down menu in the Parameters section, select the name of the original layer you want to break this new layer apart from.

Where is the Intersect tool in ArcGIS?

In ArcGIS and ArcGIS Pro, the Intersect Tool is part of the Analysis Toolbox and within the Overlay Toolset. It's a very basic tool in which you add layers that you want to intersect. You also set the ranks for how attributes will be ordered in the output feature.

How do you cut in ArcGIS pro?

1. On the Edit tab, in the Features group, click Modify .
2. In the pane, expand Divide and click Clip .
3. Uncheck Clip all editable features located at the bottom of the pane.
4. Select the input cutting features.
5. Select the target features you want to clip.

How do you split a shapefile?

1. There's a tool in the Vector menu that can split a dataset based on an attribute. Look in Vector > Data Management Tools > Split Vector Layer. It's a basic tool that should work if you don't

want to resort to plugins or tools in Processing; unless they offer additional functionality you need.

How do I convert a polygon to a line in Arcgis?

1. Start ArcMap.
2. Add the polygon feature class, shapefile or coverage to the map.
3. Convert the polygon to a polyline. A.
4. Double-click on the line layer symbol in the Table of Contents.
5. If symbolizing the lines as cased, right-click on the layer in the Table of Contents and choose "Use Symbol Levels".
