Introduction

In the Tags panel, click Default in the Dashes column for the tag to which you want to add dashed lines. Select the dashed line style from the menu that appears. Any geometry on the tag now has dashed lines.

1. Click the Shape Style panel to open it.
2. Select the entity whose stroke you want to modify.
3. Click the Stroke option to select it.
4. Select your desired stroke settings, which are explained in detail in the upcoming list.

A dash is a horizontal line that shows a pause or break in meaning, or that represents missing words or letters. Note that dashes are rather informal and should be used carefully in writing. Dashes are often used informally instead of commas, colons and brackets. A dash may or may not have a space on either side of it.

Where is the shape style panel in Sketchup?

Open the Shape Style panel by clicking its title bar. (If you don't see the panel on-screen, select Window > Shape Style from the menu bar.) Click the Pattern option, which becomes highlighted. Clicking the Pattern option tells LayOut you want to fill the selected shape with a pattern.

What's a broken line?

Definition of broken line 1 : a line composed of a series of dashes often : a guide line painted in dashes on a highway to indicate a stretch on which a driver may lawfully cross the midline of the way (as in passing another vehicle)

How do I make a dotted line in AutoCAD?

To make AutoCAD actually draw the lines with a dashed symbol, first zoom in closely to a line feature, then enter "Linetype" at the command prompt to open the Linetype Manager. Click the Load button, and select the specific Linetype to apply to the features.

Draw an edge starting at the in-line point you want to remove and going a short distance in any direction. Then erase the new edge. The endpoint will go away with the edge. You can join many segments into a single polyline entity with the Weld plugin.

What is the dotted line called?

"Dashed line" means a line made up of short strokes with breaks in between.

How do you use dashes?

Use dashes to mark the beginning and end of a series, which might otherwise get confused, with the rest of the sentence: Example: The three female characters—the wife, the nun, and the jockey—are the incarnation of excellence. Dashes are also used to mark the interruption of a sentence in dialogue: Example: “Help!

What do you call a line of dots?

The ellipsis ‘ (also known informally as dot dot dot) is a series of dots that indicates an intentional omission of a word, sentence, or whole section from a text without altering its original meaning. The plural is ellipses.

Why is my SketchUp showing lines?

Looks like you hit K to turn on back edges. Hit K again to turn them off. By the way, you might consider erasing guides once they’ve done their job.

How do you hide the lines of intersection in SketchUp?

Double-click to edit, click on empty space to quit editing. You can edit the groups forming your house and then select and hide (right-click > Hide) the edges you don’t want to see.

How do you remove imaginary lines in SketchUp?

Go to: view>hidden lines and see if lines show up. If so, you can delete the trailing off lines.

Why are my dashed lines not showing in model space?

In most cases, your issue will be related to linetype scale (LTSCALE) as it relates to Paper Space linetype scale (PSLTSCALE). However, you may have your measurement units mistakenly set to Metric when your drawing is meant to be in Imperial units (or vice versa), which can also affect the appearance of dashed lines.

How do you show a dotted line in paper space?

Why are my dashed lines not showing in paper space AutoCAD?

Solution: Do one or more of the following: In the layout, double-click inside a viewport to activate it, then type PSLTSCALE and set it to either 0 or 1.

How do you mark points in SketchUp?

You add a guide point by selecting the tape measure tool, clicking on a vertex, moving the cursor to where you want the point, and clicking again. If the new location is on the same edge as the start vertex, you will get just a guide point.
