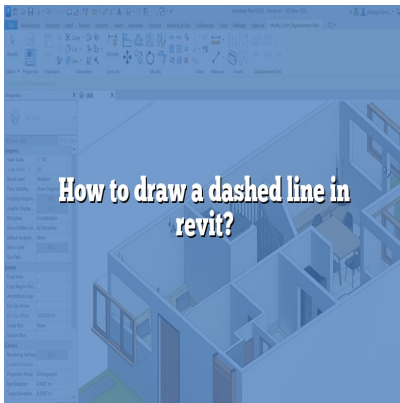




How to draw a dashed line in revit?

Description

Select the element you want to change. In the second column from the left select the "Override" button. Pull down the drop-down list of line types under "Pattern" and select the "Dash" linetype, for example. This method will change the linetype to dashed for all objects of that type.

Moreover, how do you make a dashed wall in Revit? Select the walls, right click and override elements in view, then change the projection line to dashed.

Likewise, how do you change the linetype in Revit?

1. In the Line Styles dialog, click New, and enter a new name for the line style.
2. Click the value for Line Weight to choose a line weight.
3. Click the value for Line Color to choose a line color.
4. Click the value for Line Pattern to choose a line pattern.
5. Click OK.

How do I change a solid line to a dotted line in AutoCAD?

To make AutoCAD actually draw the lines with a dashed symbol, first zoom in closely to a line feature, then enter "Linetype" at the command prompt to open the Linetype Manager. Click the Load button, and select the specific Linetype to apply to the features.

What are dashed lines?

Definition of dotted line 1 : a line that is made up of a series of dots. 2 : a line on a document that marks where one should sign Sign your name on the dotted line.

What's a broken line?

Definition of broken line 1 : a line composed of a series of dashes often : a guide line painted in dashes on a highway to indicate a stretch on which a driver may lawfully cross the midline of the way (as in passing another vehicle)

How do I draw a dotted line in AutoCAD?

We can make or draw a dashed line in AutoCAD by using the "Layer" command.

How do you create a linetype in Revit family?

1. Click Manage tab Settings panel Object Styles.
2. In the Object Styles dialog, click the Model Objects, Annotation Objects, or Imported objects tab.
3. Click in the Line Weight, Line Color, or Line Pattern cell for the category you want to modify and make changes as necessary.

How do you make a zigzag line in Revit?

Line patterns in Revit will not allow a "zig zag" or any special characters. Dashes and dots are pretty much the menu you have to choose from. "lines" with a special character can be created using a repeating detail.

What are detail lines in Revit?

The Detail Line tool has the same line styles as the Line tool, but detail lines are view-specific, like detail components and other annotations. Detail lines are drawn in the view's sketch plane. In MEP views, detail lines are sketched as full-toned lines.

How do you create a line weight in Revit?

1. Click Manage tab Settings panel Additional Settings drop-down (Line Weights).

2. In the Line Weights dialog, click the Model Line Weights, Perspective Line Weights, or Annotation Line Weights tab.
3. Click a cell in the table and enter a value.
4. Click OK.

How do you mask a line in Revit?

1. Select the "Linework" tool, pick the line you want to disappear, select the "Invisible Lines" line style from the dropdown in the ribbon.
2. Masking Region.

What is hidden line in Revit?

Model and detail elements that are obscured by other elements can be displayed using the Show Hidden Lines tool. You can use the Show Hidden Lines tool on all elements that have the Hidden Lines subcategory.

How do I use the linework tool in Revit?

1. Open the view in which you want to change line styles.
2. (Optional) To turn off Thin Lines, click View tab Graphics panel (Thin Lines).
3. Click Modify tab View panel (Linework).
4. Click Modify | Linework tab Line Style panel, and select the line style to apply to the edge from the Line Style drop-down.

Why are my lines not dashed in AutoCAD?

Most likely your line type scale is set too low. Select your line you want dashed and open the properties on it. Mostly likely it will be 1.0; increase it to around 30 and see how that looks.

How do I make a dashed line in Illustrator?

1. Create a line or shape using the line segment tool (/)
2. Go to the Appearance section of the Properties tab on the right-hand side.
3. Click Stroke to open the stroke options.
4. Tick the box marked Dashed Line.
5. Enter values for lengths of dashes and gaps in between.

Why are my dashed lines not plotting in AutoCAD?

In most cases, your issue will be related to linetype scale (LTSCALE) as it relates to Paper Space linetype scale (PSLTSCALE). However, you may have your measurement units mistakenly set to Metric when your drawing is meant to be in Imperial units (or vice versa), which can also affect the

appearance of dashed lines.

What do dashed lines mean in architectural drawings?

Lines made of short dashes in a plan view indicate things that are overhead, or rather, over the height at which the plan was "cut" usually things above about 4' from the floor.

What is broken line in drawing?

Broken lines indicate that a break has been made in the drawing of an object which is too large to be drawn on the paper and had to be cut in order to fit on it. It is common practice when you are drawing a full size set-out to use broken lines rather than draw the full view.

How do you draw a dotted line in sketch?

To create dashed lines, enter a value in the Dash field to set the length of the dashes. The Gap field, which sets the distance between dashes will automatically match this unless you set it to something different. To reset the the Gap value and have it match again, delete anything in that field.
