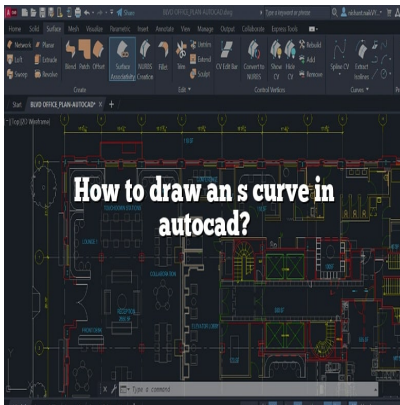

1. Click Home tab Draw panel Polyline. Find.
2. Specify the start point of the polyline segment.
3. Specify the endpoint of the polyline segment.
4. Specify additional polyline segments as needed.
5. Press Enter to end, or enter c to close the polyline.

Also know, how do you bend curve in AutoCAD?

1. In an active 3D sketch with lines, click 3D Sketch tab Draw panel Bend .
2. In the Bend dialog box, specify a Radius.
3. (Optional) Deselect Equal to prevent automatic constraints.
4. In the graphics window, click any line, sketch point, or included geometry to start the bend.

Answer. Answer: The curved line drawing tool is used to create curved or straight lines. The curved line tool provides greater control over the shape of a polyline than the straight line tool (see Drawing With the Straight Line Tool).

How do you draw distance and bearings in Autocad?

To use the Bearings option to define direction In the Toolspace, on the Toolbox tab, expand Miscellaneous Utilities Coordinate Geometry. Double-click Line by Direction and Distance. Select the end of a line from which the segment will be drawn.

How do you plot Northings and Eastings in Autocad?

1. Click Home tab Draw panel Line drop-down Create Line By Northing/Easting Find.
2. Enter a northing value.
3. Enter an easting value.
4. Continue to enter northing and easting values to define the line segments.

How do you manually plot a bearing?

How do you bend a surface in AutoCAD?

1. Select the geometry you want to bend. These are Targets and can be NURBS surfaces, meshes, and curves.
2. Choose Object Edit > Dynamic Shape Modeling > Bend Rig from the tool palette.
3. Select a single curve or a continuous sequence of curves as the bend axis.

How do you chamfer in AutoCAD?

The chamfer command in AutoCAD is used to create slanted edges. Here, 1 and 2 are the selected lines. We can create the chamfer by specifying either the chamfer distance or angle. Type CHA or chamfer on the command line or command prompt and press Enter.

How do I create a hatch pattern in AutoCAD?

1. Click File > Options > Application Options > Drafting > Hatching to display the Hatching page of the Options dialog. To create a new user-defined hatch pattern, click the Create button to display the Edit Hatch Pattern dialog.
2. Use the dialog to create/edit a hatch pattern.

How do I draw a radius in a circle in AutoCAD?

1. Do one of the following: Click Home tab Draw panel Circle drop-down Center, Radius. Find. Click Home tab Draw panel Circle drop-down Center, Diameter. Find.
2. Specify the center point.
3. Specify the radius or diameter.

What is the difference between arc and circle in AutoCAD?

A circle is 360 degrees and can be divided into four quadrants. All points on a circle are at a given distance from its center point. An arc is defined as an open curve in which all points are the same distance from its center point. By default, AutoCAD draws arcs counterclockwise.
